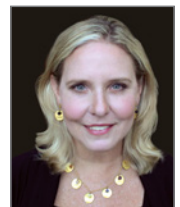

The Associated Sciences Consortium is an RSNA working group representing 11 professional societies in radiologic sciences, technology, and administration. It sponsors eight 90-minute educational courses during the annual meeting.

Bolstering Oncoradiologic and Oncoradiotherapeutic Skills for Tomorrow (BOOST) Program

Monday, November 28 to Wednesday, November 30
Leaders in radiation oncology, diagnostic radiology, biology, and physics provide 3 days of concentrated courses. Each day focuses on particular diseases and includes a refresher course on anatomy, natural history and contouring, scientific papers, and case-based reviews.

Case-based Interactive Series

Each interactive series comprises multiple sessions intended to aid self-assessment and increase knowledge. Topics include abdomen, breast, cardiac CT, MR, musculoskeletal, nuclear medicine, neuroradiology, pediatric, thoracic imaging and ultrasound. The RSNA Diagnosis Live™ audience-response system assists with self-assessment.

CIR@RSNA 2016

Monday, November 28
Imagen Cuantitativa (Biomarcadores) En La Práctica Clínica: Sesión del Colegio Interamericano de Radiología (CIR) en Español—Quantitative Imaging and Biomarkers in Clinical Practice: Session of the Interamerican College of Radiology (CIR) features presentations from our Latin American colleagues presented in Spanish with English translation.
Topics include precise and personalized medical imaging, qualitative follow-up to multiple sclerosis, non-invasive evaluation of cardiac disease by MRI, liver storage disease (steatosis, fibrosis, cirrhosis and hemochromatosis), biomarkers in diagnosis and follow-up of prostate cancer, cartilage quantitative evaluation for osteoarthritis, early response evaluation to neoadjuvant chemotherapy in breast cancer with imaging, and an oncologic response to hybrid imaging.

Essentials of Radiology

Enjoy a 2½-day series of courses for general radiologists, residents, and subspecialists who want to review other areas of radiology. Topics include breast, cardiac, chest, trauma, genitourinary, musculoskeletal, pediatric, gastrointestinal imaging, non-interpretive skills and neuro.

Hands-on Workshops

Use of medical equipment and/or devices is demonstrated during 1½-hour workshops. Course topics include MR imaging-guided breast biopsy, techniques for interventional sonography and thermal ablation, 3D printing, hands-on musculoskeletal ultrasound, carotid and renal doppler and fallopian tube catheterization.



Hospital Administrators Symposium

Wednesday, November 30
Designed for hospital administrators and healthcare executives, this session will cover future health payment and delivery changes and their relationship to radiology, practical techniques for leading change in radiology, and understanding methods of radiology data analysis that may be helpful to a hospital.

Liver Symposium

Friday, December 2
Make the most of the last day of RSNA 2016, for a full-day liver imaging symposium presented cooperatively with French Society of Abdominal Imaging, Society of Abdominal Radiology, Japanese Society of Abdominal Radiology and Korean Society of Abdominal Radiology.
Detection, staging and characterization of liver cancer, particularly in patients with chronic liver disease, is among the most published, clinically relevant and challenging issues facing radiologists today.
The topic draws world research and educational communities together in ways that have dramatically impacted radiology’s participation in the clinical care of affected patients.
Topics include a look at American, Asian and European guidelines for screening and diagnosing HCC; novel concepts in hepatobiliary tumor imaging including state-of-the-art techniques, management issues, benign liver tumors, bile duct tumors, and the role of CEUS and MRI in imaging of FNH.



Molecular Imaging Symposium

Monday, November 28
This series of sessions addresses molecular imaging for the practicing radiologist with topics including oncology, radiogenomics and brain imaging.

NIH Grantsmanship Workshop

Saturday, November 26
This workshop offers a greater understanding of the NIH grants process for preparing a research or training grant application, learning the elements of a competitive grant application and gaining insight into new features of the NIH review process. The workshop also illustrates the review process in action through a mock study section.

Quality Improvement Symposium

Tuesday, November 29
This series of three sessions focuses on quality improvement in a radiology practice. RSNA will award Quality Essentials Certificates of Completion to attendees who score 80% or higher on the tests.

RSNA Diagnosis Live™

These exciting expert-moderated sessions feature a series of interactive case studies to challenge radiologists’ diagnostic skills. Submit and discuss your responses with your colleagues in a fast-paced game format. Bring your own charged mobile device to participate in the competition.

RSNA/ESR Symposium

Topics include a look at the Asian and North American perspectives of imaging for selection and prioritization of LT candidates with HCC, as well as imaging of liver donors and imaging after loco regional treatment as a bridge to transplant and assessment of response.

Self-Assessment Modules (SAMs)

Various times
The American Board of Radiology (ABR) granted approval to RSNA for SAM Deemed Status. This allows RSNA to develop and implement, without prior ABR review, enduring SAMs and in-person (“live”) SAMs that satisfy ABR Part II MOC requirements. Select RSNA courses have been approved for SAMs. Each RSNA in-person SAM is available for up to 1.5 SAM credits and 1.5 *AMA PRA Category 1 Credits™*. RSNA annual meeting in-person SAMs are accredited by the MOC program of the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada and approved by the Canadian Association of Radiologists.

Special Interest, Hot Topics, and Controversies

These sessions address radiology-related topics that are late-breaking, particularly controversial, or programs the RSNA Board of Directors deemed of particular importance.
