Cancer education plays a key role in the nation's war to end cancer suffering and death. Refund Policy

A 75% refund of the Conference registration fees will be given for cancellations received on or prior to 13 September 2021. No refunds will be made after 13 September 2021. No refunds will be made to individuals who attend a portion of the Conference. No refunds will be granted for problems or disruptions in the virtual conference platform where the sessions are being streamed or any other incidents during the virtual Conference which are beyond the control of the Conference organizers. The Conference organizers reserve the right to substitute faculty, or cancel or reschedule sessions (because of low enrollment or other circumstances). If the organizers must cancel the Conference in its entirety, ICEC may refund the appropriate registration fees to all Conference registrants.

Refunds in case of Emergency

If you are unable to attend the workshop(s) or the Conference based on serious illness or death (of self or a family member), a partial refund (amount paid minus a \$55 processing charge) may be granted. If you are unable to attend workshops or the Conference, you are welcome to send a colleague in your place. There is no fee to make this change up to 13 September 2021. Substitutions after 13 September 2021 will incur a \$55.00 processing fee.

Returned Check Policy

Remittance must be made in U.S. Dollars to the American Association for Cancer Education (AACE). A \$25.00 surcharge may be assessed to cover any collection fees.

Important Payment Note

The registration form must be accompanied by your credit card information or check in full payment of all applicable fees.
