Explain how bone loss affects outcome scores in patients with shoulder instability; Compare use of remplissage vs Latarjet procedures in treatment of traumatic anterior shoulder instability; Choose ideal candidates for comprehensive arthroscopic management of advanced shoulder osteoarthritis; Cite evidence supporting use of reverse shoulder arthroplasty for treatment of irreparable rotator cuff tear without glenohumeral osteoarthritis; Employ lower trapezius transfer in massive irreparable posterior-superior rotator cuff tear.
