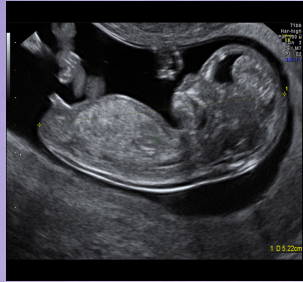

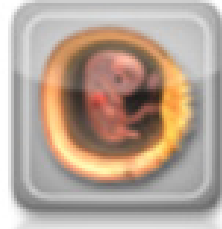

- List the components of a standard, limited and specialized obstetrical ultrasound examination.
