This lecture is designed to address critical problems encountered when performing root canal therapy using modern techniques to solve them. Using state of the art reciprocating and rotary instruments and techniques should allow the clinician to deal with diverse intracanal obstructions and curvatures in order to clean and shape the root canal efficiently to the root canal terminus.

Dr. Jorge Vera is a Diplomat of the American Board of Endodontics and a Clinical Assistant Professor at the University of Buffalo. He has a Postgraduate Endodontic Certificate from Tufts University, School of Dental Medicine, Boston, MA (1993), and is a recipient of the Samuel Seltzer award from the Oral Surgery, Oral Medicine, Oral Pathology, Oral Radiology, and Endodontics Journal (2005). He serves on the Scientific Advisory Board for the Journal of Endodontics and the International Endodontic Journal. Dr. Vera has delivered over 500 lectures in 38 countries, including at meetings of the European Society of Endodontics and the American Association of Endodontists. He has published 87 endodontic articles and contributed to three books: "Irrigation in Endodontics" (2015), "Atlas of Endodontic Surgery" (2017), and "Endodoncia" (2011). He maintained a private practice limited to endodontics from 1993 to 2020.

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
