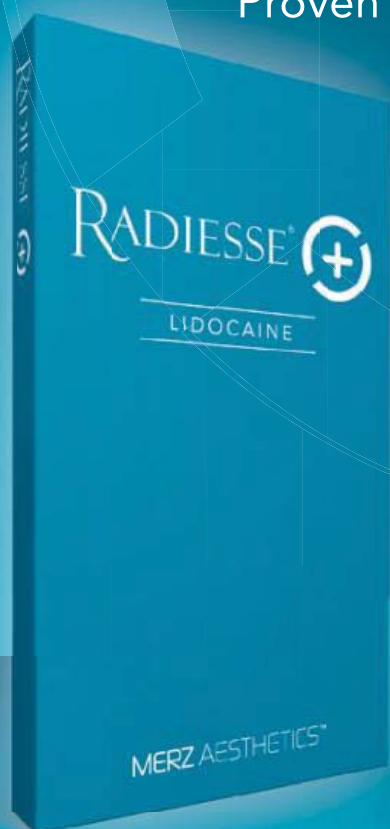

In de placebogecontroleerde periode van de klinische studies bij patiënten met psoriasis en patiënten met arthritis psoriatica was het infectiecijfer 1,27 per patiëntjaar in **follow-up** bij patiënten behandeld met ustekinumab, en 1,17 bij patiënten behandeld met placebo. De incidentie van ernstige infecties was 0,01 per patiëntjaar in **follow-up** bij patiënten behandeld met ustekinumab (5 ernstige infecties in 616 patiëntjaren in **follow-up** en 0,01 bij patiënten behandeld met placebo (4 ernstige infecties in 287 patiëntjaren in **follow-up**). In de gecontroleerde en niet-gecontroleerde periodes van klinische studies bij psoriasis en arthritis psoriatica, met gegevens van blootstelling van 9.848 patiëntjaren bij 4.135 patiënten, was de mediane **follow-up** 1,1 jaar: 3,2 jaar voor studies bij psoriasis en 1,0 jaar voor studies bij arthritis psoriatica. Het infectiecijfer was 0,86 per patiëntjaar in **follow-up** bij patiënten behandeld met ustekinumab, en het cijfer van ernstige infecties was 0,01 per patiëntjaar in **follow-up** bij patiënten behandeld met ustekinumab (107 ernstige infecties in 9.848 patiëntjaren in **follow-up**). De gemelde ernstige infecties waren diverticulitis, cellulitis, pneumonie, sepsis, appendicitis en cholecystitis. In klinische studies ontwikkelden patiënten met latente tuberculose die tegelijkertijd werden behandeld met isoniazide geen tuberculose. **Maligniteiten:** In de placebogecontroleerde periode van de klinische studies bij psoriasis en arthritis psoriatica was de incidentie van maligniteiten (uitgezonderd niet-melanome huidkanker) 0,16 per 100 patiëntjaren in **follow-up** voor patiënten behandeld met ustekinumab (1 patiënt in 615 patiëntjaren in **follow-up**), in vergelijking met 0,35 voor patiënten behandeld met placebo (1 patiënt in 287 patiëntjaren in **follow-up**). De incidentie van niet-melanome huidkanker was 0,65 per 100 patiëntjaren in **follow-up** voor patiënten behandeld met ustekinumab (4 patiënten in 615 patiëntjaren in **follow-up**) in vergelijking met 0,70 voor patiënten behandeld met placebo (2 patiënten in 287 patiëntjaren in **follow-up**). In de gecontroleerde en niet-gecontroleerde periodes van klinische studies bij psoriasis en arthritis psoriatica, met gegevens van blootstelling van 9.848 patiëntjaren bij 4.135 patiënten, was de mediane **follow-up** 1,1 jaar: 3,2 jaar voor studies bij psoriasis en 1,0 jaar voor studies bij arthritis psoriatica. Maligniteiten, uitgezonderd niet-melanome huidkankers, werden gemeld bij 55 patiënten in 9.830 patiëntjaren in **follow-up** (incidentie bij de patiënten behandeld met ustekinumab: 0,56 per 100 patiëntjaren in **follow-up**). Deze incidentie van maligniteiten gemeld bij patiënten behandeld met ustekinumab was vergelijkbaar met de incidentie verwacht in de algemene bevolking (gestandaardiseerde incidentieratio = 0,92 [95%-betrouwbaarheidsinterval: 0,69, 1,20], aangepast voor leeftijd, geslacht en ras). De maligniteiten die het vaakst werden waargenomen, anders dan niet-melanome huidkanker, waren prostaat-, melanoma-, colorectaal- en borstkankers. De incidentie van niet-melanome huidkanker was voor patiënten behandeld met ustekinumab 0,50 per 100 patiëntjaren in **follow-up** (49 patiënten in 9.815 patiëntjaren in **follow-up**). De verhouding van patiënten met basaalcelhuidkankers ten opzichte van patiënten met plaveiselcelhuidkankers (4:1) is vergelijkbaar met de verhouding die verwacht kan worden bij de algemene bevolking. **Overgevoeligheidsreacties:** ijdens de gecontroleerde periodes van klinische studies met ustekinumab bij psoriasis en arthritis psoriatica zijn rash en urticaria elk waargenomen bij < 1% van de patiënten. **Immunogeneciteit:** Minder dan 8% van de patiënten behandeld met ustekinumab in klinische studies ontwikkelden antilichamen tegen ustekinumab. Er werd geen duidelijke associatie waargenomen tussen de ontwikkeling van antilichamen tegen ustekinumab en de ontwikkeling van reacties op de plaats van de injectie. De meerderheid van de patiënten die positief waren voor antilichamen tegen ustekinumab hadden neutraliserende antilichamen. Er was een tendens tot een lagere effectiviteit bij patiënten positief voor antilichamen tegen ustekinumab; positiviteit voor antilichamen sloot een klinische respons echter niet uit. **Pediatriche patiënten:** Bijwerkingen bij pediatriche patiënten van 12 jaar en ouder met plaque psoriasis. De veiligheid van ustekinumab is onderzocht in een fase 3-studie tot 60 weken bij 110 patiënten van 12 tot 17 jaar. In deze studie waren de gerapporteerde bijwerkingen vergelijkbaar met de bijwerkingen die in eerdere studies werden gezien bij volwassenen met plaque psoriasis. **Melding van vermoedelijke bijwerkingen:** Het is belangrijk om na toelating van het geneesmiddel vermoedelijke bijwerkingen te melden. Op deze wijze kan de verhouding tussen voordelen en risico's van het geneesmiddel voortdurend worden gevolgd. 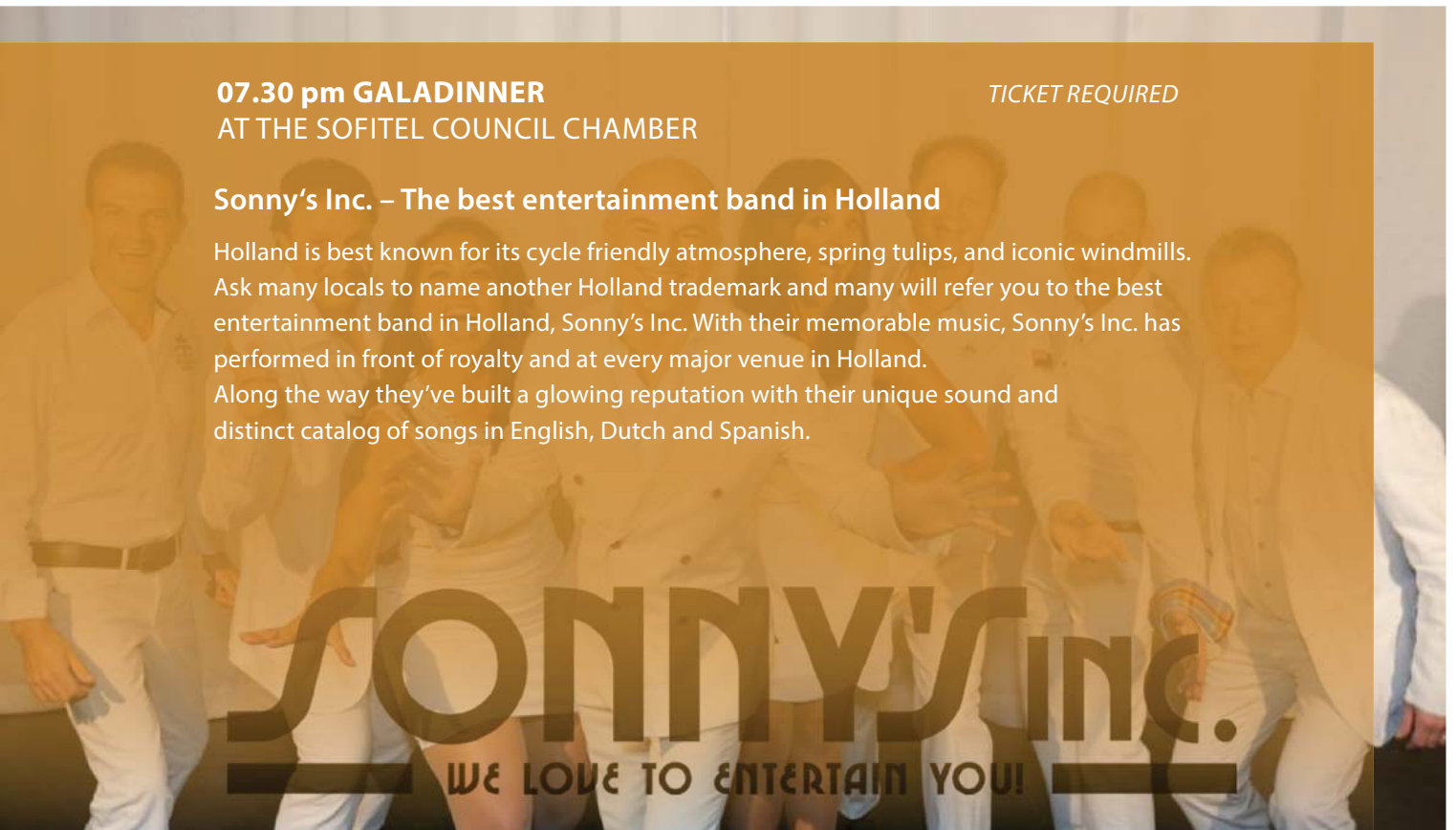
