Travel south on the interstate I-75 to exit 107 (Pine Ridge Road). Turn westbound on Pine Ridge Road and travel approximately 4.5 miles. Pine Ridge Road becomes Seagate Drive after you cross U.S. 41. Continue west on Seagate. This will take you to The Naples Grande Resort entrance.
