Arthritis to Arthroplasties in Arizona: Is an advanced course for physician assistants who treat arthritis of the extremities and spine in adults and children. Transportation

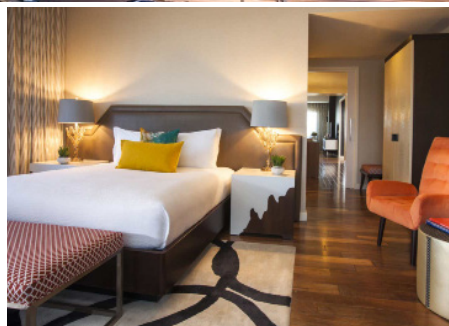
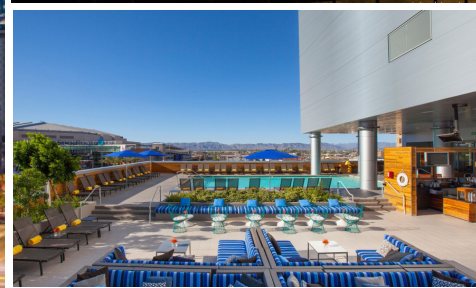
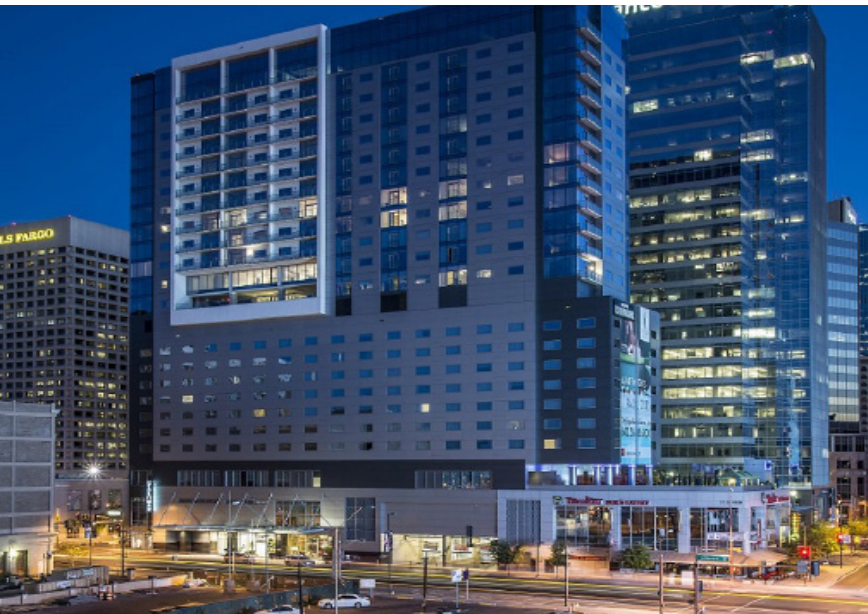
Airport: Sky Harbor International Airport is 3.5 miles east of the hotel.
