COURSE DESCRIPTION AND STATEMENT OF NEED

A partnership between primary care physicians and rheumatologists is critical to identify situations that require immediate as well as long term management. This one-day symposium is designed to provide primary care physicians or those that provide primary care to their patients with up-to-date information on how to recognize, diagnose, treat, and follow common rheumatologic conditions. This CME certified activity will emphasize early diagnosis, identification of risk factors for prognosis, intervention early rather than later, and side effects or toxicities to treatment strategies. Morning lecture topics will focus on the management and treatment of certain conditions such as rheumatoid arthritis, treatment of fibromyalgia, advances in treatments for lupus and ankylosing spondylitis, and the use of imaging techniques in the diagnosis and treatment of rheumatic conditions. In the afternoon, our popular hands-on sessions with the experts will emphasize office-based practices such as joint examinations and injections, how to monitor and assess the safety of biologic agents, what to do with a positive ANA and anti-CCP antibody test result and what you need to know about the latest management of osteoarthritis and osteoporosis.

TARGET AUDIENCE

This educational activity is for family practice and other primary care physicians, internists, rheumatologists, physicians-in-training, nurse practitioners and other healthcare professionals interested in optimizing the diagnosis, management, and treatment of patients with musculoskeletal disorders.

EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES

- Diagnose SLE and associated comorbidities in patients earlier and recognize the signs of poor prognosis that may require more aggressive monitoring and therapy
- Identify the new treatment options and emerging pharmacologic treatments and behavioral and physician therapies in the management of patients with fibromyalgia
- Identify how ultrasound can be used to successfully manage patients with rheumatic conditions
- Utilize advanced imaging techniques available in most imaging departments to aspirate a suspicious joint
- Determine appropriate treatment for patients with osteoporosis based on risk profile and the latest treatment guidelines
- Assess the importance of evaluating high risk patients for osteoporosis and how to determine the need for bone mineral density testing
- Implement screening and diagnostic procedures to diagnose ankylosing spondylitis early, and before permanent bone damage occurs
- Apply recommendations from current guidelines for the treatment and management of ankylosing spondylitis to improve patient outcomes
- Utilize serological markers (ANA, rheumatoid factor, anti-CCP antibody) and MRI imaging techniques to improve detection of early onset rheumatoid arthritis
- Apply recommendations from current treatment guidelines for the management of osteoarthritis to improve patient care
- Examine joints and surrounding structures to make a differential diagnosis among acute and chronic rheumatic diseases
- Perform injection techniques to manage soft tissue conditions and aspirate joints for diagnostic and therapeutic reasons
