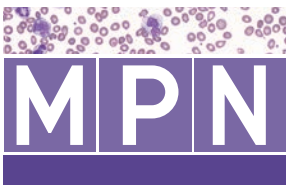

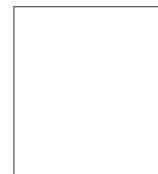

Call for Abstracts

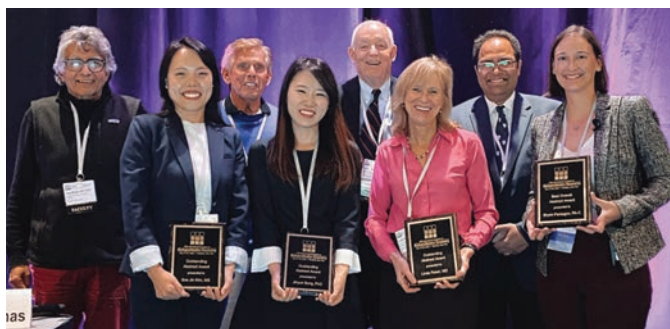

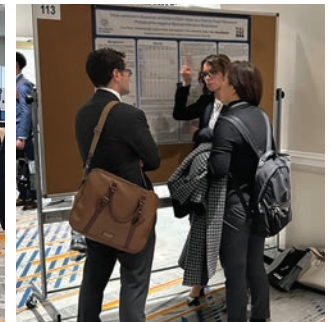


New York Marriott at the Brooklyn Bridge 333 Adams Street | Brooklyn, NY 11201

Discounted Group Rate

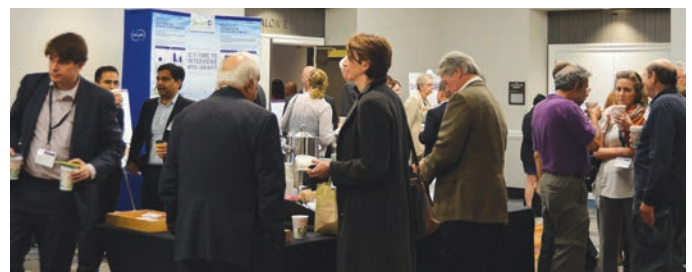
