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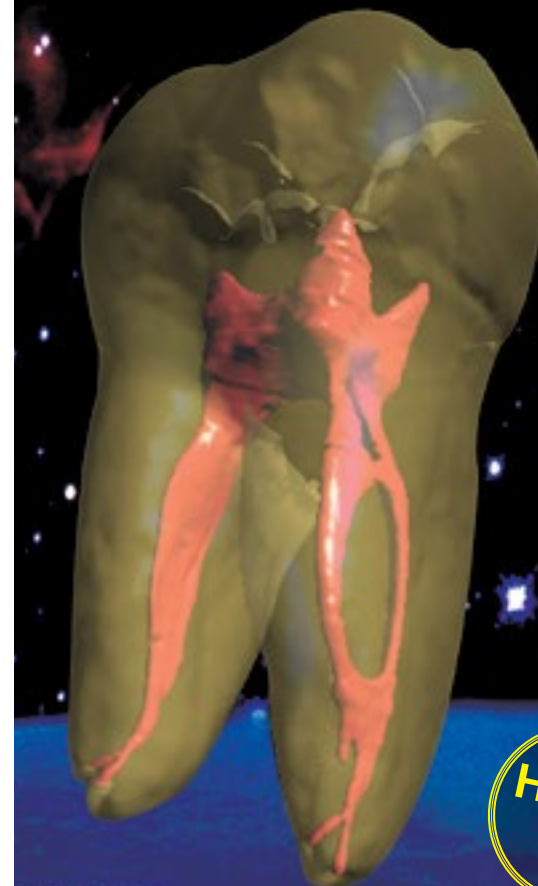

Synopsis

Molar endodontics often present challenges to the clinician. These may include difficulty in isolation and access, negotiation of curved and narrow root canals, difficulty in canal obturation, and managing anatomical variations. However, today many advances in technology, materials and equipment have made it possible to efficiently perform successful molar endodontic treatment with more precision and predictable results.

This two-day intensive course includes lectures and hands-on workshops and is specially designed for General Dentists who wish to advance their clinical skills when performing molar endodontics. Participants will learn how to perform efficient endodontic access, clean and shape the root canal system and finally obturate in a predictable manner. Participants will also perform endodontic treatment from start to finish in maxillary and mandibular molar teeth. Without a doubt, this course will help you master molar endodontics.

This course is recommended for doctors at any level who are interested in improving their clinical skills and treat endodontically molar teeth. It will provide participants with practical information and predictable techniques on how to perform appropriate endodontic access, and clean, shape and obturate the root canal system in three dimensions to improve treatment outcomes.

Topics to be discussed:

- Endodontic anatomy and morphology of molar teeth
- Modern principles of endodontic access
- Root canal length determination - radiographic and electronic
- Cleaning and shaping of molar root canals
- Nickel Titanium rotary instrumentation
- Procedural errors and their prevention
- Root canal obturation
- Case selection for molar endodontics

Upon Completion of the Course Participants Should Be Able To:

- Enhance knowledge of clinical concepts of molar endodontics
- Successfully treat both maxillary and mandibular molar teeth
- Apply system-based approaches when treating endodontic cases
- Approach molar endodontic cases with more confidence and enjoy more predictable results

This course is intended for dentists at any level who are interested in improving their clinical skills and safely perform endodontic treatment in molar teeth.

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
