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LIST OF TOPICS AND AREAS OF INTEREST

- **Perinatal Psychosomatics:** Fetal, Newborn and Maternal Biopsychosocial Health, Preparation for Childbirth and Parenting. Fear of Childbirth. Obstetrical PTSD. Psychosocial aspects of preterm Delivery. Prevention of Post natal depression. Postpartum bonding and difficult breastfeeding.
- **Psychosomatic Gynecology and Menopause.** Chronic Pelvic Pain, Premenstrual disorders. Endocrine influence on mood.
- **Sexuality**, including psychosocial consequences of Pelvic floor Dysfunctions.
- **Education in Psychosomatics** and Women's Psychosocial Health for Ob Gyns, Family Doctors, Midwives, Pediatricians and Nurses. Workshops, Balint or case discussion groups.
- **Professional wellbeing** (burn out prevention).
- **Psychoanalysis** and clinical issues.
- **Ethical issues.** Cesarean on demand, abortion counselling.
- **Social issues** influencing womens health (Working conditions. Drug addictions. Eating disorders Violence, Migration, Genital Cosmetic or Cultural Surgery, Rape, Mutilations).
- **Psychiatry and OB Gyn Care.** (Mental health, Psychopharmacology in pregnancy or postpartum. Maternal and Menopausal Depression, Suicide prevention/ detection, etc.).
- **Fertility issues.** Contraceptive counseling. Psychosomatic collaboration in assisted reproduction teams.
- **Psycho-Oncology.** Preventive Fertility Preservation
- **Neonatology** and psychosocial issues.
- **Historical** and epistemological contributions.

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
