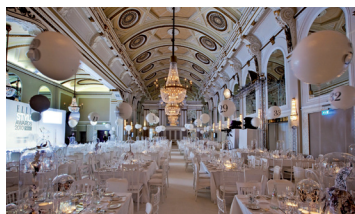
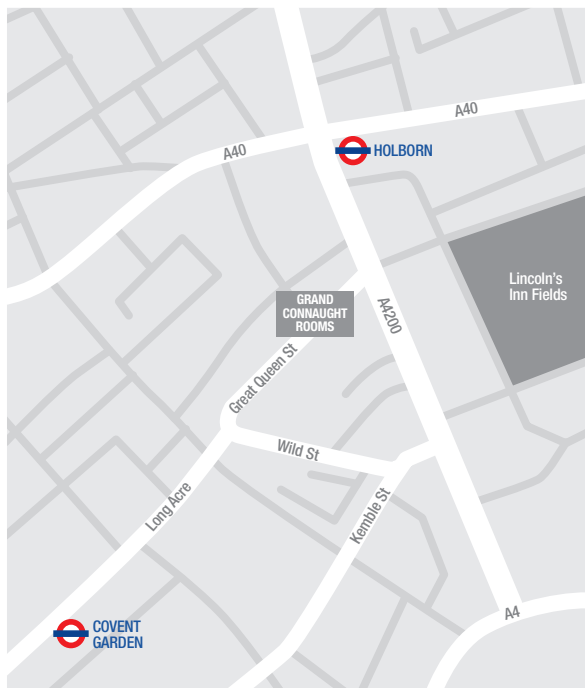
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VENUE INFORMATION

Grand Connaught Rooms 61-65 Great Queen Street London, WC2B 5DA

The iconic Grand Connaught Rooms is one of London's most impressive, stylish and opulent conference venues, in the heart of central London. It is close to Covent Garden, with its unique vibrancy, culture and variety of culinary excellence and within a short walk of the Theatre district.

The venue is a short stroll to two tube stations, with three major train stations within five minutes by taxi, many buses and close to London city airport. There are fast transport links in every direction, and if you want to drive – there is parking close by too.



By train:

- London Euston, Kings Cross and St Pancras International stations are under a thirty minute walk from the hotel or a short taxi ride
- Kings Cross station is just three stops away on the London Underground's Piccadilly line
- All of London's remaining mainline stations, including London Victoria, Paddington and Waterloo are easily reached by the Underground network

By London Underground

- Nearest Underground station: Covent Garden (Piccadilly line) is a short walk from the venue
- The Piccadilly line connects Kings Cross station with London Heathrow Airport, by central London
- Heathrow airport is approximately 40 minutes by tube from Covent Garden
