- Accessing clinical trials
- How to work through treatment or take time off
- Applying for disability insurance
- Managing medical bills, finances, and getting financial help
- Becoming an empowered patient and advocate
- Dealing with how to grow after trauma

FREE CES/CONTACT HOURS:
