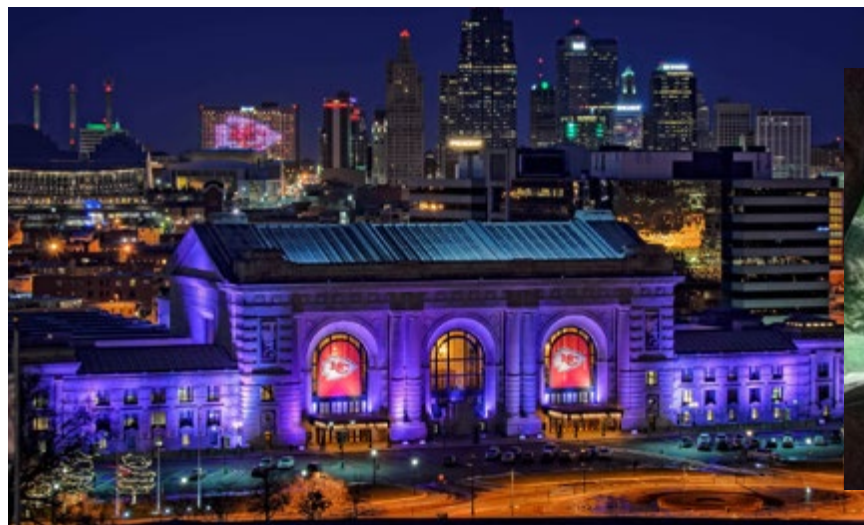

Reasons to attend

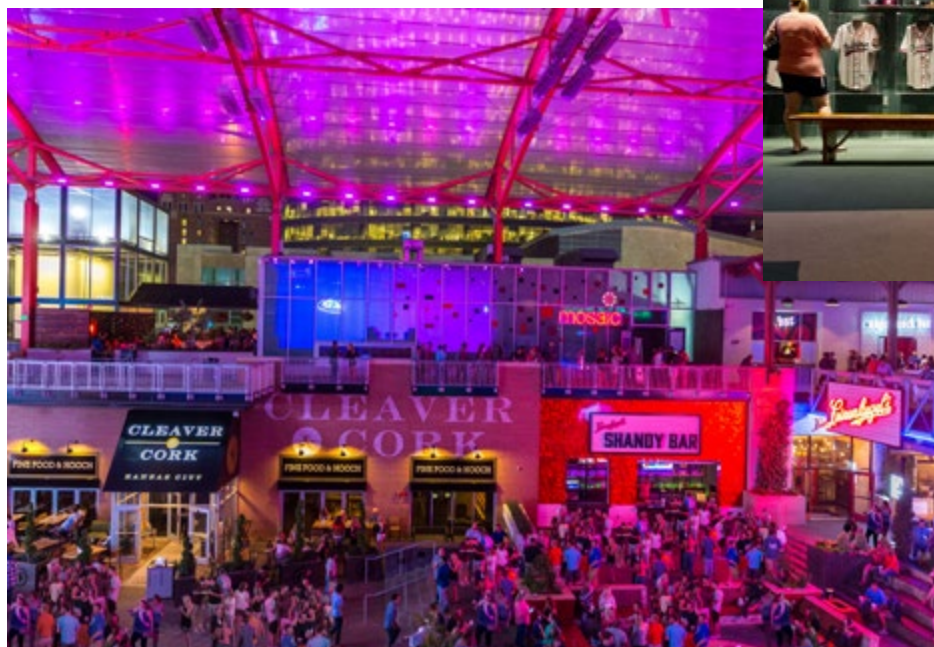

- Written statement describing the reasons the nominee should be named Nurse Leader of the Year by the person nominating (include a description of the nominee's dedication and contributions to the field of long-term care)
- Letters from co-workers, families, residents or others should describe why the nominee should be named Nurse Leader of the Year (total of 3 points can be attained)
- **Deadline is 4/15/24**

Process:

- Candidates must be a current member of NADONA.
- Candidates may be nominated by other members, colleagues, Administrators, Medical Directors or any other health professional involved in long-term care.
- Candidates may self-nominate.
- Candidates will be selected by an Awards Committee who will be comprised of NADONA members.
- Candidates will not be identified by name to the Awards Committee.
- Awards will be given during the Tuesday Lunch Awards Banquet.
- One award per region will be presented, provided each region is represented and nominations are received prior to the deadline.
- The nominee obtaining the highest number of points will be awarded "National Nurse Leader of the Year".
- Current National Board Members are not eligible during their term of office.

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

This scholarship has been established in memory of Stephanie Carroll, a long-time valued NADONA employee. It will be awarded to a nursing student enrolled in an accredited nursing program who has chosen Long-Term Care or Geriatrics as their practice area after graduation. Nursing students in an undergraduate or graduate program are also eligible to apply for this scholarship. The following guidelines have been developed for this scholarship.

1. Proof of acceptance to a nursing program for the 2024-25 academic year and accreditation must accompany the application.
2. Applicant must make a commitment to practice in long-term care or geriatrics for at least two years after graduation.
3. Applicant should include an organized list of school-related expenses with a final total
4. Applicant must submit with their application a double-spaced essay of NO LESS THAN 100 WORDS. This essay must include the following:
 - Describe your commitment to the nursing profession, including your goals for your nursing career after graduation.
 - Discuss why you are seeking this degree and how it will impact your nursing practice.
5. Please upload a head shot in .jpg format.
6. Applicant cannot be awarded more than one NADONA scholarship in any one year.
7. Scholarship monies are not required to be awarded if only one applicant applies
