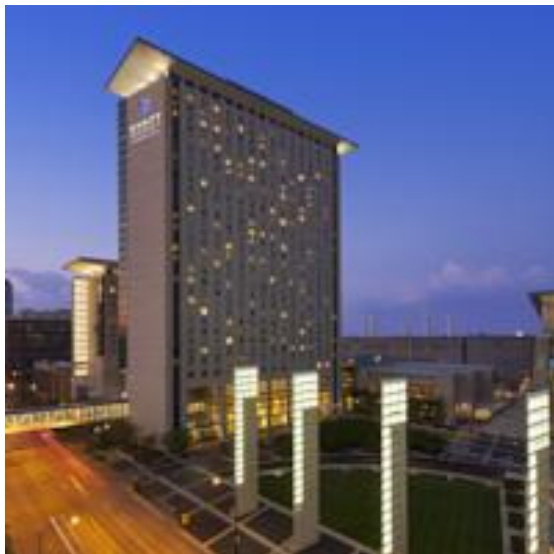

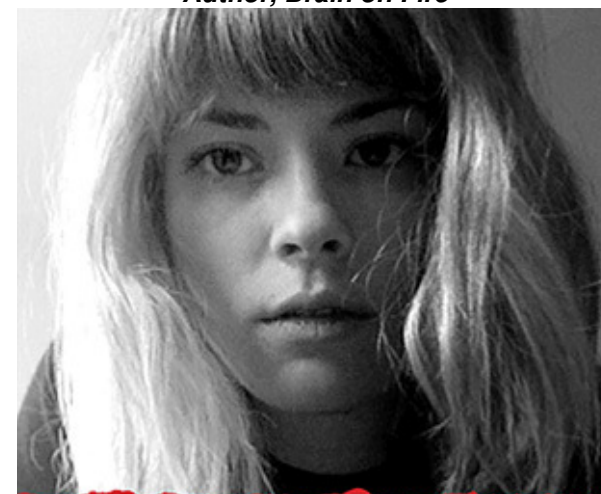

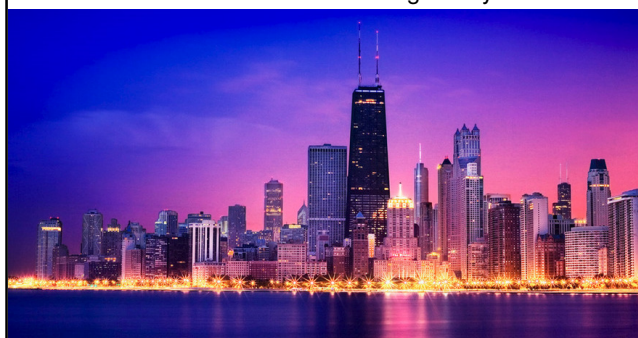

Taxi:

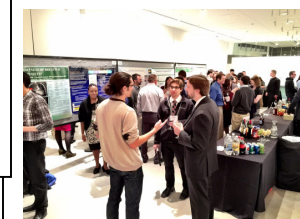
Fare from Chicago O'Hare is \$40-45; fare from Chicago Midway is \$20-25; depending on traffic.

Airport Express:

Train:

- From Chicago O'Hare: Blue line to towards Forest Park to Clark/Lake, transfer to Green Line (\$2.25/one way) to the Cermak-McCormick Place stop. Hotel is located 2 1/2 blocks east.
- From Chicago Midway: Orange line toward Loop (\$2.25/one way) to the Roosevelt stop. Hotel is located 1 block east.
