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About Coimbatore & Venue

COIMBATORE

Often known as the 'Manchester of India', Coimbatore or Kovai is the second largest city of Tamil Nadu and one of the fastest growing cities of India. Situated at the foot hills of Nilgiris, it is known for its pleasant climate, peaceful atmosphere, cosmopolitan outlook and private enterprises. This city a major hub for textiles, industries, commerce, education and information technology. In spite of its prominence as a bustling industrial city, Coimbatore still remains as one among the pollution-free cities in India. Coimbatore is a major healthcare hub and popular for its medical tourism.

Connectivity

Coimbatore being a business city, with varied manufacturing and trading activities, is well-connected to major cities in India.

By Road: Coimbatore city is connected by national highway – NH-47, NH-67 and NH-209. Buses travel from major cities and towns in Tamil Nadu and other states to Coimbatore.

By Rail: Coimbatore has three railway junctions (terminals) - Coimbatore Central, Coimbatore North and Podanur.

By Air: Coimbatore has an International Airport, which is connected to all the major metropolitan cities in India.

Weather: Coimbatore has a pleasant, salubrious climate due to its proximity to thickly-forested mountain ranges and cool breeze blowing through the Palghat gap. It is located at an elevation of about 411 meters. The maximum and minimum temperatures varies between 35°C (95°F) and 18°C (64°F).

CODISSIA TRADE FAIR COMPLEX

The Coimbatore district small scale industry (CODISSIA) a significant forum in Coimbatore, has established 'CODISSIA Trade Fair Complex', one of the India's largest trade fair complex and a recognized venue in the industrial and exhibition industry of Tamil Nadu. Well-known amongst the regional exhibiting companies for hosting some of the most notable events and conferences in South India, it has been the main inspiration for all upcoming exhibition venues in the country. Places to Visit in Coimbatore

Dhyanalinga

The Dhyanalinga is a Yogic temple located 30 km from Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu. The temple was created by Sadhguru Jaggi Vasudev, a profound mystic and yogi. It is the first-of-its-kind to be completed in over 2,000 years. The temple offers a meditative space that does not ascribe to any particular faith or belief system.



Marudhamalai (temple)

Subramaniaswami Temple, Marudamalai is a 12th century temple dedicated to Hindu god Murugan, in Coimbatore. The temple is situated atop a hillock, 12 km west from Coimbatore city. There are various water bodies around the temple, namely Maruda Theertham and Snake charmer's spring, which is believed to possess medicinal properties.



Perur Pateeswarar Temple

Perur Pateeswarar Temple is a famous Shiva temple located at Perur, in western part of Coimbatore. Lord Shiva, known as 'Patteeswarar', is the main deity of this temple. Dating back to the 11th century, this temple has several gopurams and halls, famous of which is the one with the golden statue of Nataraja. The pillars have carvings of the various manifestations of Shiva and the ceiling has a series of stone chains.

Siruvani Waterfalls

The Siruvani Waterfalls and dam are located some 35 km to the west of Coimbatore city amidst the lush Western Ghats. The Siruvani River is the main source of water to the Coimbatore city and its water is famous for its sweet taste and mineral properties. The view from the Siruvani falls and the dam attracts tourists from around the world.



Indira Gandhi Wildlife Sanctuary

Indira Gandhi Wildlife Sanctuary and National Park is a protected reserve located in the Coimbatore District of Tamil Nadu. The park was formerly known as Anaimalai wildlife sanctuary and derived its name from 'Anai' (meaning elephant) and 'Malai' (meaning hills) from the large number of wild elephants living in the area.



Ooty

Ooty is a popular hill station located in the Nilgiri Hills, some 80 km north of Coimbatore. Ooty. Popularly known as the 'Queen of Hill Stations', it is adorned with beautiful mountains, lakes, miles of tea gardens and forests all around. Its natural beauty attracts tourists and it is a popular summer destination. Ooty is also known as the 'Blue Mountains owing' to the indigo cover of the beautiful Kurinji flower that blooms on the slopes of the Nilgiris once every 12 years. Ooty is nature at its best with diverse flora and fauna.

Coonoor

At a distance of 18 km from Ooty, 71 km from Coimbatore, Coonoor is a beautiful hill station in the Nilgiris district in the state of Tamil Nadu. Coonoor is the second largest hill station in the Nilgiri hills after Ooty and is home to variety of wildflowers, birds and lush environs. It is an ideal base for a number of trekking expeditions leading into the Nilgiris. Coonoor is known for its production of Nilgiri tea. The Nilgiri Mountain Railway ride, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, in the midst of the Nilgiris, is an unforgettable travel experience.
