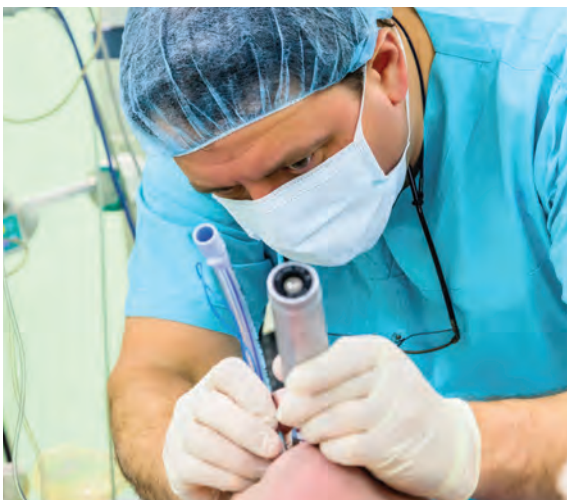
EDUCATIONAL METHODS
