Jeffrey Hammoudeh MD DDS is board certified in oral and maxillofacial surgery and plastic surgery and holds faculty appointments at Keck School of Medicine of USC and Herman Ostrow School of Dentistry of USC. He is director of the Jaw Deformities Care Program within the division of Plastic and Maxillofacial Surgery at Children's Hospital Los Angeles.

Rick Ritt MA-EMT-Paramedic has been a paramedic over 45 years; 13 as paramedic officer with the Chicago Fire Department. With involvement in all areas of dental simulation, Rick established Dental Simulation Specialists to provide training and promote patient safety. He published *Simulation Training for the Office Based Anesthesia Team* in the OMS Journal of North America

Jay Reznick DMD MD received his undergraduate biology degree from UC Berkeley, dental degree from Tufts University and MD degree from USC. He trained in oral and maxillofacial surgery at LA County/USC Medical Center. Dr Reznick specialized in integrating CBCT and CAD/CAM in his practice. He recently relocated his practice from Tarzana, California to Savannah, Georgia.

Roberta Ashley CRNA EdD CHSE (Ret) practiced at LA County/USC Medical Center specializing in trauma anesthesia, training MD anesthesiology and oral and maxillofacial surgery residents. She was awarded Doctor of Educational Psychology and the Certified Healthcare Simulation Educator credential. Dr Ashley spent 15 years prior to her appointment at USC as an ICU nurse.

Steve Yun MD is an MD and Dental Anesthesiologist in Southern California. He is also a safety inspector for surgery centers and an examiner and expert consultant for the Dental Board of California. He received his MD from the University of Southern California then completed three years of additional training in Anesthesiology at the UCLA Medical Center.

Steven Sadowski DDS is a professor in the Department of Preventive and Restorative Dentistry at the University of the Pacific Arthur A. Dugoni School of Dentistry. He was previously in full-time private practice limited to prosthodontics. Dr. Sadowski is the former president of the American Prosthodontic Society and the Pacific Coast Society for Prosthodontics.

Dale Stringer DDS has been practicing oral and maxillofacial surgery in Riverside for over 30 years. He is also a professor in the department of oral and maxillofacial surgery at Loma Linda University Medical Center where he has taught in the OMS residency program for over 30 years. Dr Stringer specializes in orthognathic surgery.

Tuan Hoang DDS MD completed undergraduate studies at UC Santa Barbara then attended the University of Southern California for dental school. Dr Hoang pursued post graduate training in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery at the Louisiana State University, New Orleans Health Sciences Center where he underwent extensive training in maxillofacial trauma and reconstruction.

Baldwin Marchack DDS MBA earned his DDS from the USC School of Dentistry and MBA from UCLA. He is a past president of the American Prosthodontic Society, the Pacific Coast Society for Prosthodontics, the American Academy of Esthetic Dentistry and the Osseointegration Study Club of Southern California. His practice is Pasadena Prosthodontics.

Alan Kaye DDS is past president of Los Angeles Dental Society, California Dental Society of Anesthesiology, CALAOMS, and the Dental Board of California. He was Dental/Oral Surgery Clinical Chief at Cedars Sinai Medical Center. Dr Kaye has played a key role in presenting risks of drug abuse to dental organizations, community groups, and specifically to high school audiences.

Stanley Malamed DDS is a dentist anesthesiologist and Emeritus Professor of Dentistry at the Ostrow School of Dentistry of USC where he is Professor of Anesthesia and Medicine. His residency in anesthesiology was at Montefiore Hospital and Medical Center in New York. He is the author of *Handbook of Local Anesthesia, Emergency, Medicine in Dentistry and Sedation*.

Tom Einstein MD is Director of Anesthesia at the Clavin Center in Santa Monica; UCLA School of Medicine; Internship and Residency in Emergency Medicine at Harbor-UCLA Medical Center in Torrance; UCLA Residency in Anesthesiology; On staff at Santa Monica-UCLA Medical Center; Anesthesia provider for outpatient surgery and office-based dental and oral surgery.

Kyle Yip MS DDS MD is a board certified oral and maxillofacial surgeon who specializes in jaw surgery and complex dentoalveolar surgeries. He is the OMS residency program director at Harbor-UCLA Medical Center. Dr Yip completed his undergraduate, masters, and dental training at UCLA before earning his medical degree and oral and maxillofacial surgery training at USC.

Ed Bedrossian DDS is Director of Advanced Implant Reconstruction and Clinical Professor in the Department of OMS at Arthur A Dugoni School of Dentistry, University of the Pacific. He received his DDS from University of the Pacific, and completed his Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery Residency at Alameda Medical Center. Dr Bedrossian has a private practice in San Francisco.

Dennis-Duke Yamashita DDS is Professor of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery at the Herman Ostrow School of Dentistry of USC and holds adjunct appointments in the Division of Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery and the Department of Otolaryngology at the Keck School of Medicine of USC. Dr Yamashita is affiliated with Children's Hospital of Los Angeles.

Jay Fedorowicz DDS MD specializes in head and neck surgery. His oral and maxillofacial surgery residency was at David Grant USAF Medical Center. He completed a specialized program in head and neck surgery and microvascular reconstruction surgery at University of California San Francisco Fresno. Dr Fedorowicz has two offices, in Napa and Sonoma, California.
