This session will focus on the treatment of complicated metastatic spinal conditions and best practices. Focus on what the community can do to assist the tertiary and quaternary surgeon. We will also discuss community treatment of metastatic lesions and cartilage tumors often seen incidentally. Which require further workup or intervention?

2:30 PM SESSION FIVE: SHOULDER | ELBOW

The major focus of this session is the younger patient with a very large, irreparable rotator cuff tear and no arthritis. Faculty will present evidence on reverse total shoulder, and tendon transfers. We will also review the evidence and best practice for shoulder dislocations, do we wait for the next one or is there an indication for surgery? We will also review the medial epicondyle fractures with emphasis of best practice and when referral to pediatric orthopaedic specialists is recommended.

3:45 PM SESSION SIX: HAND | WRIST

This session with focus on wrist arthritis and discuss the latest evidence and indications for proximal row carpectomy, wrist fusion and total wrist replacement. We will also examine scapholunate ligament injuries and indications for operative and nonoperative management.
