

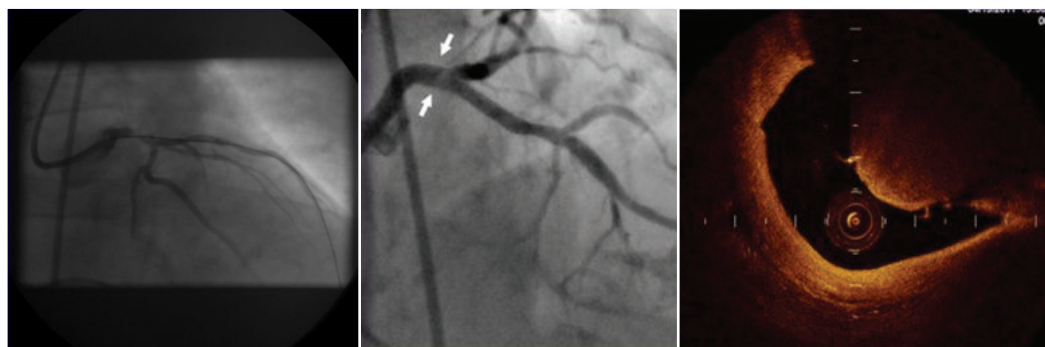
Left Main Stem Disease and its Management
