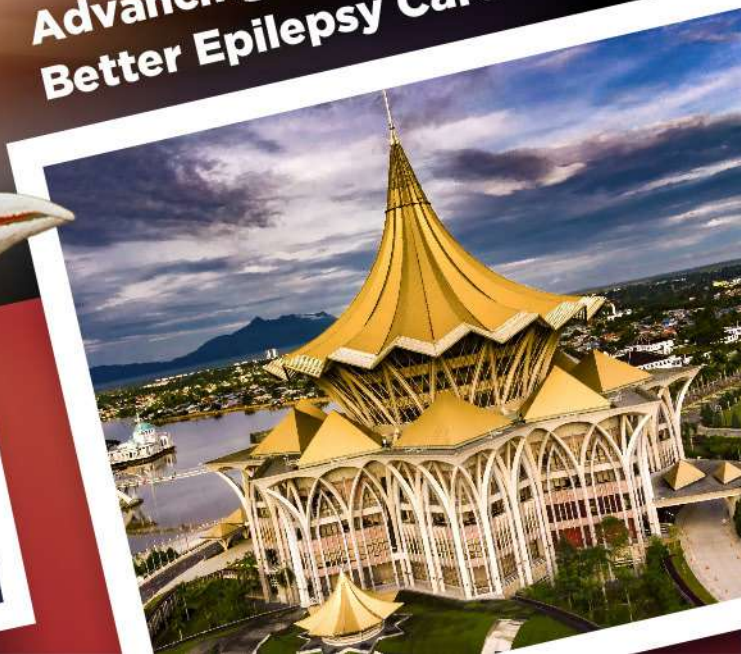

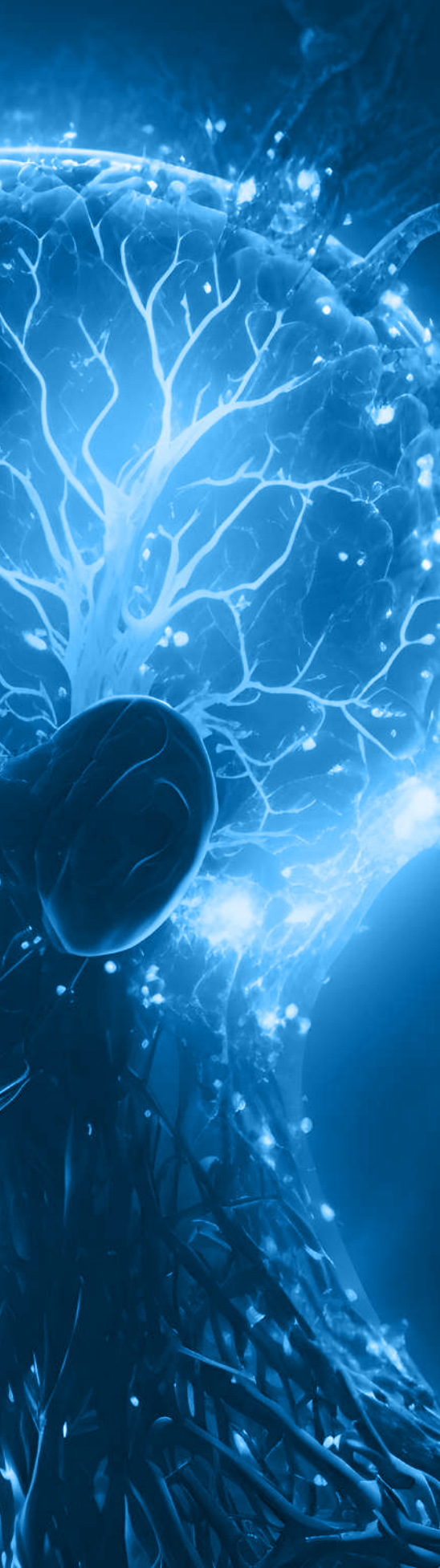

WELCOME MESSAGE BY PRESIDENT



The Malaysian Society of Neurosciences (MSN) is hosting its 31st Annual Scientific Meeting in Kuching, Sarawak in the month of September 2023. The theme centered around for this year's chapter will be "*Epilepsy*," a condition that is vulnerable to reduce one's quality of life and precipitate a stigmatized society. I anticipate positive outcomes from this scientific meeting that will be carefully crafted to facilitate live plenary sessions, symposiums, oral presentations, and exhibition booths that aim to showcase the latest technological advancements and innovations to promote a revolutionized epileptic care in Malaysia. We would be meeting in-person for a mind cultivating analytical transfer of knowledge, debates, and the latest updates on evidence-based practices to inform the neurological practitioners. I advocate enlightenment through case-based discussions across a variety of neurological disorders that we have encountered. Abundant of opportunities will be made avail to share knowledge, to exchange ideas, and to initiate collaborations. Let's meet, communicate, and network to set the stage for a solid avenue in neurosciences! Abstract Submission Guidelines

1. Abstract must be submitted online via the Congress website. Final forms of presentation can be in any of the following format:-
 - Oral Presentation
 - E-Poster Presentation
2. Tables, graphs and images are not permitted.
3. Abstract submitted by fax, email or post will not be accepted.
4. Abstract must be submitted on or before **31st May 2023**. The online submission system will close at midnight GMT on this day.
5. Abstract must be received by the announced deadline. Abstract received after the deadline will not be considered.
6. Please do not submit multiple copies of the same abstract.
7. Abstracts must be original. Encore Abstracts are not accepted.

Notification Of Decision

1. All abstracts will be forwarded to the Scientific Program Committee for review.
2. Notifications regarding status of your abstract will be sent once the review process is complete.
3. The presenting author will be informed of the presentation details, including presentation type (oral or poster), scheduled presentation day and time.
4. The results will be released by **30th June 2023**.

Presentation at the Congress

1. Instructions for preparation of poster presentations will be sent together with acceptance notifications.
2. The committee will endeavor to schedule abstracts according to authors' preferences but reserves the right to decide on the final form of presentation.

Preparing Your Abstract for Submission

The abstract should be as informative as possible and include the following details:-

- **Introduction:** background and specific objective of the study
- **Methods:** description of methods used
- **Results:** summary of results obtained
- **Conclusion:** conclusion reached

It is not acceptable to simply state "The results will be discussed".

Abstracts must meet the following specifications:

1. Abstract title: Limited to 25 words in UPPER CASE
2. Abstract should be accompanied by the authors' names and affiliations.
3. Abstract text: Limited to 300 words (NOT including Authors and Affiliations)
4. Abstract topic: Abstract must be allocated to a specific topic from below:-
 - Adult Neurology
 - Child Neurology and Developmental Paediatrics
 - Basic Neuro Science
5. Use only standard abbreviations. Special or unusual abbreviations are not recommended. If otherwise necessary, the latter should be placed in parenthesis after the first mentioned of the full word.
