SYNOPSIS

Into its sixth consecutive year, this highly successful and unique airway workshop in Singapore utilizes realistic part-task simulators and **real cadavers** to teach advanced airway skills, and is facilitated by a diverse panel of experts.

The approach will be **talk-less-do-more**, with an emphasis on practical fiberoptic techniques, as well as emergency airway rescue procedures such as cricothyroidotomies.

Group size is deliberately kept small, with a high faculty / delegate ratio, in order to enhance experiential learning.
