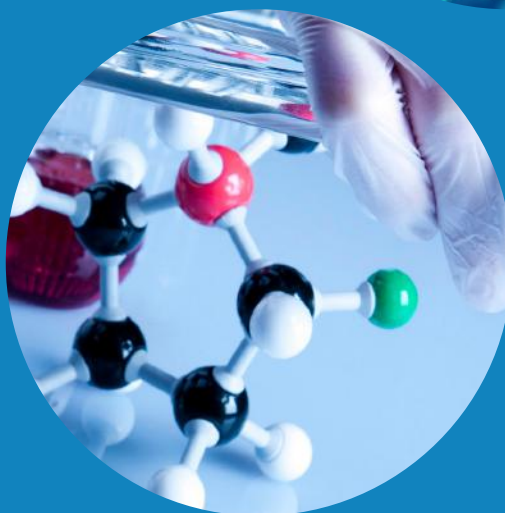

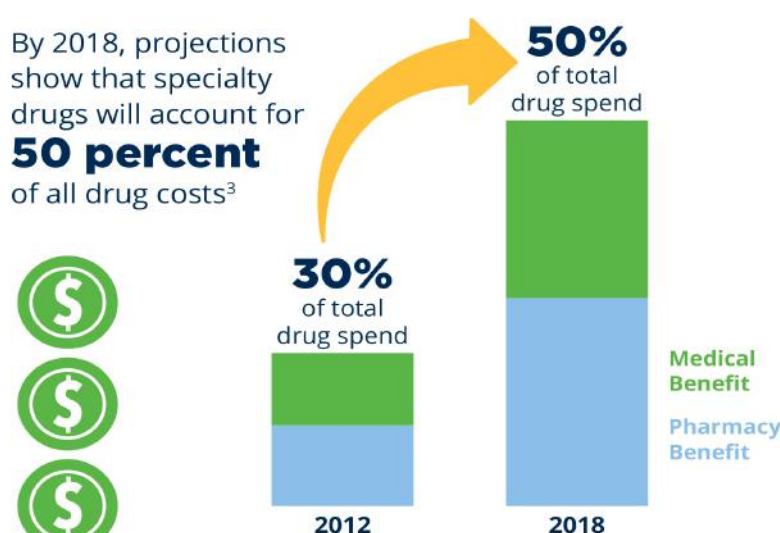
- ➔ Negotiating rebates from drug manufacturers

Effective management is needed

In 2020, **9 of the 10** best-selling drugs by revenue will be specialty drugs, compared with 3 out of 10 in 2010, and 7 out of 10 in 2014²



By 2018, projections show that specialty drugs will account for **50 percent** of all drug costs³



Compared to traditional retail drugstores, specialty pharmacies offer deeper discounts and enhanced services to employers and consumers. Specialty pharmacies will

save an estimated \$250 billion over the 10-year period 2016–2025.⁴

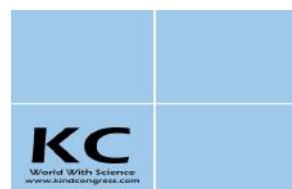
