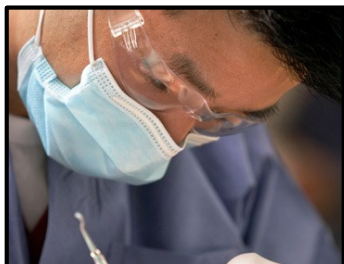
Heather M. Rogers, BSDH

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REFUND/CANCELLATION POLICY – You may register up to the date of the course if there is space available.
