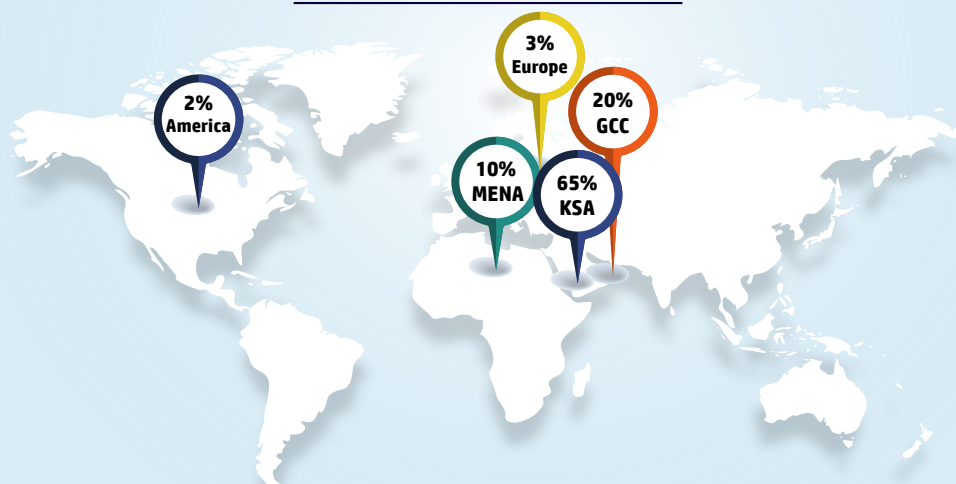

Good Distribution Practices for Temperature-sensitive Pharmaceuticals

The Middle East and the GCC region particularly are experiencing massive growth in the logistics industry and the region is becoming a hub for international trade and logistics. Couple this with the fact that governments all over the region are focusing increasingly on improving healthcare delivery. Biopharmaceuticals, bio-similars, vaccines and other temperature sensitive pharma products are increasingly forming the backbone of Middle East health.
