Prof William Faquin is the Director of Head and Neck Pathology at the Massachusetts General Hospital and the Massachusetts Eye and Ear Infirmary in Boston, MA. He is a Professor of Pathology at Harvard Medical School and is widely recognised for his dedication to teaching and contributing to the field of Head and Neck Pathology and Cytology. He has authored several peer reviewed publications and co-authored books on head and neck cytohistology, salivary gland and thyroid cytopathology. Dr Faquin is the current co-chair of the College of American Pathologists Evidence-based Guidelines Committee, developing national guidelines for the assessment of head and neck lesions for high risk HPV.

Dr Michael Henry is the previous President of the American Society of Cytopathology and is the current Director of General Cytotechnology at Mayo Clinic. Dr Henry's medical interests include gynaecologic cytopathology, FNA, Upper GIT and pancreatobiliary pathology. Dr Henry has published widely and has lectured both nationally and internationally on several cytology topics.
