# SCAP2026 KEYNOTE SPEAKERS



## Keynote Speaker

### **Dr David Shum**

**Yeung Tsang Wing Yee and Tsang Wing Hing Professor in Neuropsychology, Chair Professor of Neuropsychology and Dean of Faculty of Health and Social Sciences, The Hong Kong Polytechnic University**

Professor David Shum received his Bachelor of Arts (1st Class Honours in Psychology) from Massey University, New Zealand, and his Doctor of Philosophy (in Neuropsychology) from The University of Queensland, Australia. Before moving to Hong Kong, he spent almost three decades working at Griffith University, Australia. Currently, he is a Chair Professor of Neuropsychology and the Dean of the Faculty of Health and Social Sciences at the Hong Kong Polytechnic University. He is also the Yeung Tsang Wing Yee and Tsang Wing Hing Endowed Professor in Neuropsychology. He has over 35 years of experience in the assessment and rehabilitation of higher-level cognitive functions (e.g., attention, memory, and executive function) in normal and brain-injured children and adults. In recent years, he has been spending more time and effort in understanding the nature of prospective memory (i.e., remembering to do things in the future) and social cognition in older adults and examining their relationships with everyday functioning, mental health, and quality of life.

Professor Shum has published his research in top journals and as books, book chapters, psychological tests, and encyclopedia entries. He has also been successful in attracting national and internal competitive research grants from funding bodies such as the Australian Research Council, the National Health and Medical Research Council in Australia, the Hong Kong Research Grants Council, and the Hong Kong Health Medical Research Fund.



## Conference Co-Chair/ Keynote Speaker

### **Dr Brian Moore**

**University of Wollongong, Australia**

Dr Brian Moore is a senior lecturer and researcher at the University of Wollongong whose research promotes mental health and wellbeing. With a professional background as a psychologist and educator, Brian has significant experience working with children, adolescents, and their families. He is committed to promoting youth mental health as an important outcome in its own right and due to the impact mental health has on related factors including educational achievement. Brian's most recent work examined a martial arts-based psychosocial intervention with adolescents. This work has been translated in an international collaboration with researchers in regional India. Additionally, Brian is leading an international study examining community expectations regarding teachers supporting student mental health.

Brian gained a Bachelor of Arts from The University of Sydney, has multiple postgraduate qualifications in education and psychology, and was awarded a Doctor of Philosophy by Macquarie University. He is an executive committee member of the School Counsellor and Psychology Association NSW, an advisory committee member for the Australian and New Zealand Mental Health Association, and is a Special Advisory Group member of UNESCO's International Centre of Martial Arts for Youth Development and Engagement.

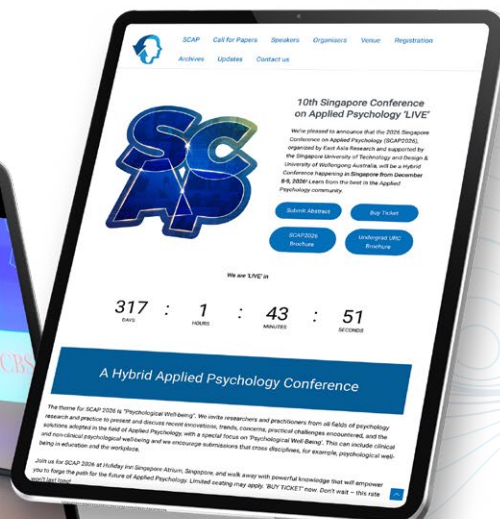


## Conference Co-Chair

### **Dr Yow Wei Quin**

**Professor & Assoc. Head of HASS (Research), Singapore University of Technology and Design**

Professor Yow Wei Quin is currently Head of Humanities, Arts & Social Science at the Singapore University of Technology and Design, and a visiting Senior Academician at the Changi General Hospital. She obtained her PhD (Psychology), MA (Psychology) and MSc (Statistics) from Stanford University, USA. Her main area of research is examining socio-cognitive development across the lifespan, including how factors such as the language environment that we grow up in influence our cognitive functioning, as well as how technology influences the way we communicate and interact with each other. Professor Yow has published more than 70 international peer-refereed papers, conference proceedings and book chapters in top-tiered journals and conferences such as Developmental Science, Child Development, Journal of Gerontology Series B, Bilingualism: Language & Cognition, Innovation in Aging, Frontiers in Psychology, Cognitive Development, GSA, SRCD, Cognitive Science Society, etc., in the area of social cognition, bilingualism, technology and aging. She also currently serves in the Editorial Board for Cognitive Development and Frontiers in Psychology, Consulting Editor for Child Development, co-Chair of Publications Committee, SRCD, and Associate Editor for Innovation in Aging (from January 2024), and a recipient of multiple awards, such as the Public Administration Medal (Bronze), GSA Diversity Mentoring & Career Development Fellowship, SUTD Outstanding Education Award, and the Society of Personality and Social Psychology Teacher/Scholar Award.
