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PATIALA ATTRACTIONS



GURUDWARA SHRI DUKHNIWARAN SAHIB, PATIALA

One of the most popular Gurudwaras in Punjab, Gurudwara Dukh Niwan Sahib is a Gurdwara in Lehal which is now a part of Patiala and is quite famous for curating virtues. Looked after by the Shiromani Gurdwara Parbandhak Committee, visitors have faith in the healing qualities of the water here and pay an annual tribute to this Gurdwara. According to the HukamNama, it is believed that if anyone with ailments or illnesses takes a dip in the pond with complete devotion and attention can be fully cured. Visitors can take part in a lot of activities apart from praying here such as volunteering to help feed people or keeping the Gurdwara clean. A number of people visit this Gurdwara, not only on special occasions such as Basant Panchmi (the day when Guru Tegh Bahadur Ji arrived here), Gurunanak Jayanti or Lohri but this place is also often visited by newly-wed couples and new-borns.

BARANDARI GARDEN

The importance Baradari garden can be ascertained from its name. This name was formed with two words of Punjabi Bara and Dar. Bara stands for twelve and dar stands for doors. It means garden with twelve entrances. It was built in a Mughal style in 1876 by Rajinder Singh. Baradari gardens are in the north of Patiala city. It is situated in the outer part of Sheranwala Gate. Baradari gardens were constructed near the Baradari palace. Baradari palace was a residence of Emperor Rajinder Singh. He brought rare species of trees and flowers from different places and planted them in this garden. The big fruit trees the Fern House and the Rock Garden shows his interest towards nature. Another name of Rajinder Kothi is Baradari Kothi because it is situated near the Baradari Garden. Today, the Baradari Palace is a warehouse of important historical documents.



MOTI BAGH PALACE

Located in Moti Bagh in Patiala, Moti Bagh Palace is an ancient magnificent palace that attracts a lot of tourists to the place. Originally built in the 1840s by the Maharaja of Patiala, the premises of the palace were expanded in 1920 under the rule of Maharaja Bhupinder Singh. Boasting of striking architecture with chhatris and jharokas, and exuding old world charm, it is home to 15 dining halls. Lately, a part of the palace has been converted into a museum and the remaining into National Institute of Sports. The repository, also known as the Sheesh Mahal is home to a lot of relics of art and culture, and several paintings belonging to the 20th century which are done in the Rajput and Kangra styles. In addition to this, the walls are adorned with medals collected and awarded by the consecutive Maharajas.

QILA MUBARAK

Famous for its forts, museums and places of historical importance, Patiala is home to pleasing structures and architecture built in the days of yore. Sikh Palace architecture with its distinct beauty and unmatched style adorn the district of Patiala. One such structure that is a famous tourist spot among visitors as well as locals is the Qila Mbarak. A great example of Sikh architecture, the Qila is an imposing structure that reminds one of the glorious history of the place. The genesis of the Qila can be traced back to the times of Baba Ala Singh. It is believed to have been constructed in 1763, though the foundation stone is believed to have been laid in 1754. Maharaja Amar Singh, Grandson of Baba Ala Singh completed the construction in 1763. The founder of Patiala dynasty built it as a mud fortress and the Qila has undergone a lot of changes since then.



PATIALA HERITAGE WALK

Patiala, located in the India state of Punjab, is a city steeped in history and culture. One of the best ways to explore this heritage is through the Patiala Heritage Walk, a guided tour that takes visitors through the city's most important historical landmarks and cultural hotspots. The Patiala Heritage Walk is a curated experience designed to showcase the best of the city's rich heritage. The walk covers a distance of around 3 kilometres and lasts approximately 2 hours. It is led by knowledgeable local guides who give visitors insights into Patiala's history, culture, and way of life. The walk begins at the famous Qila Mubarak, a sprawling 10-acre fort that was once the residence of the Patiala royal family. Visitors are guided through the various rooms and courtyards of the fort, which boasts an impressive collection of paintings, weapons, and artefacts.
