Course Description

Offered in a standardized format that can be used as a competency assessment to validate the knowledge and skills of experienced clinicians. Participants analyze case scenarios using key physiologic principles. The sessions offer demonstration, practice, and testing of the following skills:

- Auscultation
- Performing Leopold's Maneuvers
- Placement of an internal monitors (FSE, IUPC)
- Interpretation of tracings
- Identification of indicated interventions
- Communication
- Documentation

Prerequisite: ≥ 6 months obstetric experience

2 day course = 18 CNE (Attendance required both days)

Course Description

The content presented in this workshop builds on the essential knowledge and skills gained through the Intermediate Course. Using a case study approach, this course focuses on the analysis of complicated FHM patterns/ characteristics and related case information, emphasizing the following:

- Underlying maternal-fetal physiology
- Instrumentation
- Interpretation
- Intervention
- Verbal and written communication skills
