A Practical Guide to Effective Nurse Prescribing in Cardiology

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Chaired by Hannah Waterhouse, President of The British Association for Nursing in Cardiovascular Care, this important national conference provides an essential update for current and aspiring nurse prescribers in cardiology and cardiovascular care.
