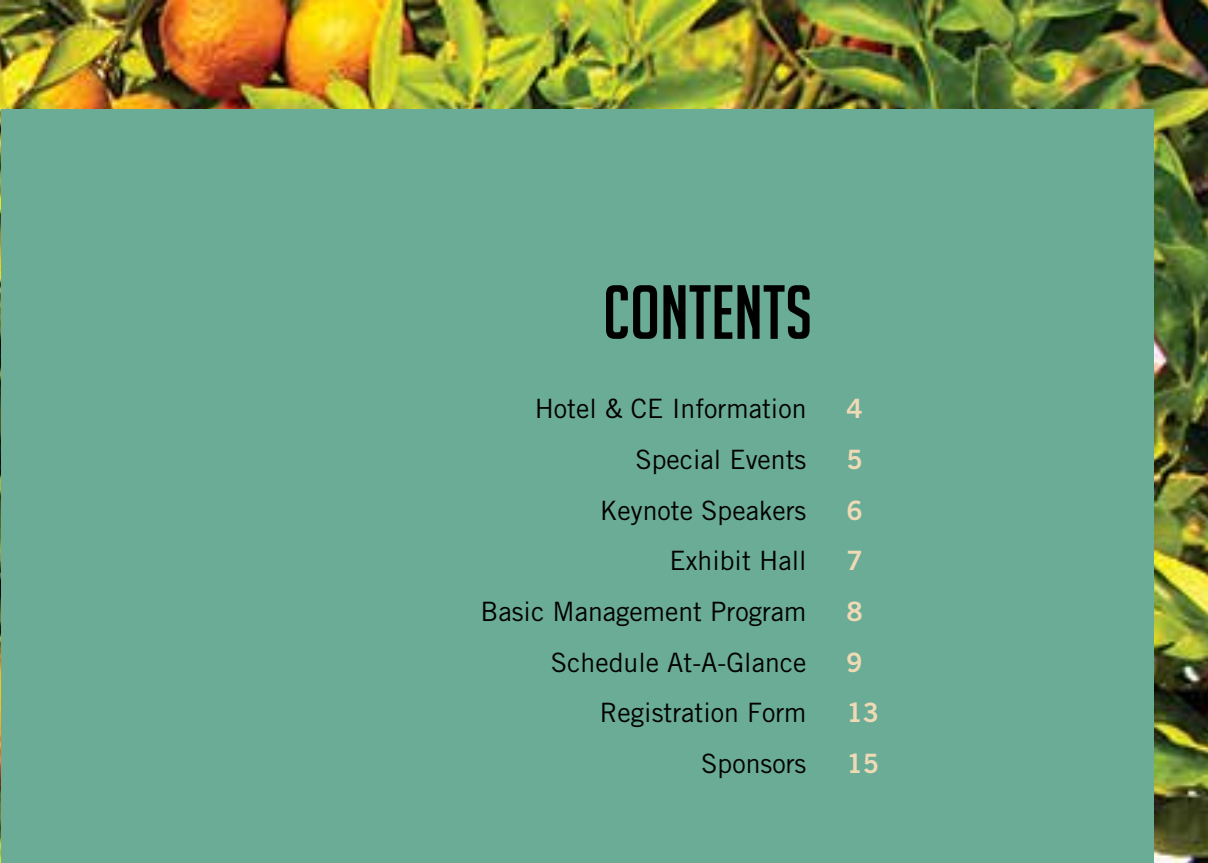

CONTINUING EDUCATION INFORMATION
