Welcome to Practical Gastroenterology, a conference planned by primary care professionals and gastroenterologists for all primary care providers. Gastroenterological disorders occupy a large part of any primary care provider's practice and are also an increasingly common reason for in-patient consultation. The purpose of this conference is two-fold:

(1) to provide answers to the most common questions posed to us by primary care practitioners, internists and hospitalists and

(2) to update attendees on four key topics in the field of Gastroenterology

Purpose and Objectives

Purpose: Attendees will be updated on the cost-effective management of common gastrointestinal symptoms and disorders. In addition, their knowledge on four key topics in gastroenterology and hepatology will be expanded. Clinical vignettes and audience response will provide immediate feedback on knowledge acquired during the conference.

Objectives: *The participants should be able to:*

- Achieve confidence in the management of the common gastrointestinal disorders observed in clinic and the hospital in collaboration with a consulting gastroenterologist
- Identify indications for esophageal manometry in patients with dysphagia
- Inform patients less than 50 years of the yield of upper endoscopy for dyspepsia
- Explain the multidisciplinary management of Barrett's esophagus
- Describe the clinical manifestations, diagnosis and management of gastroparesis
- Review the most current therapies approved by the Food and Drug Administration for the treatment of chronic hepatitis C during the last 12 months
- Summarize the latest guidelines on the management of chronic hepatitis C genotype 1
- Describe the indications and limitations of invasive procedures in patients with chronic abdominal pain
- Apply national colon cancer screening and surveillance guidelines to patients at average and high-risk for colon cancer development
- Discuss new perspectives in Clostridium difficile pathogenesis
