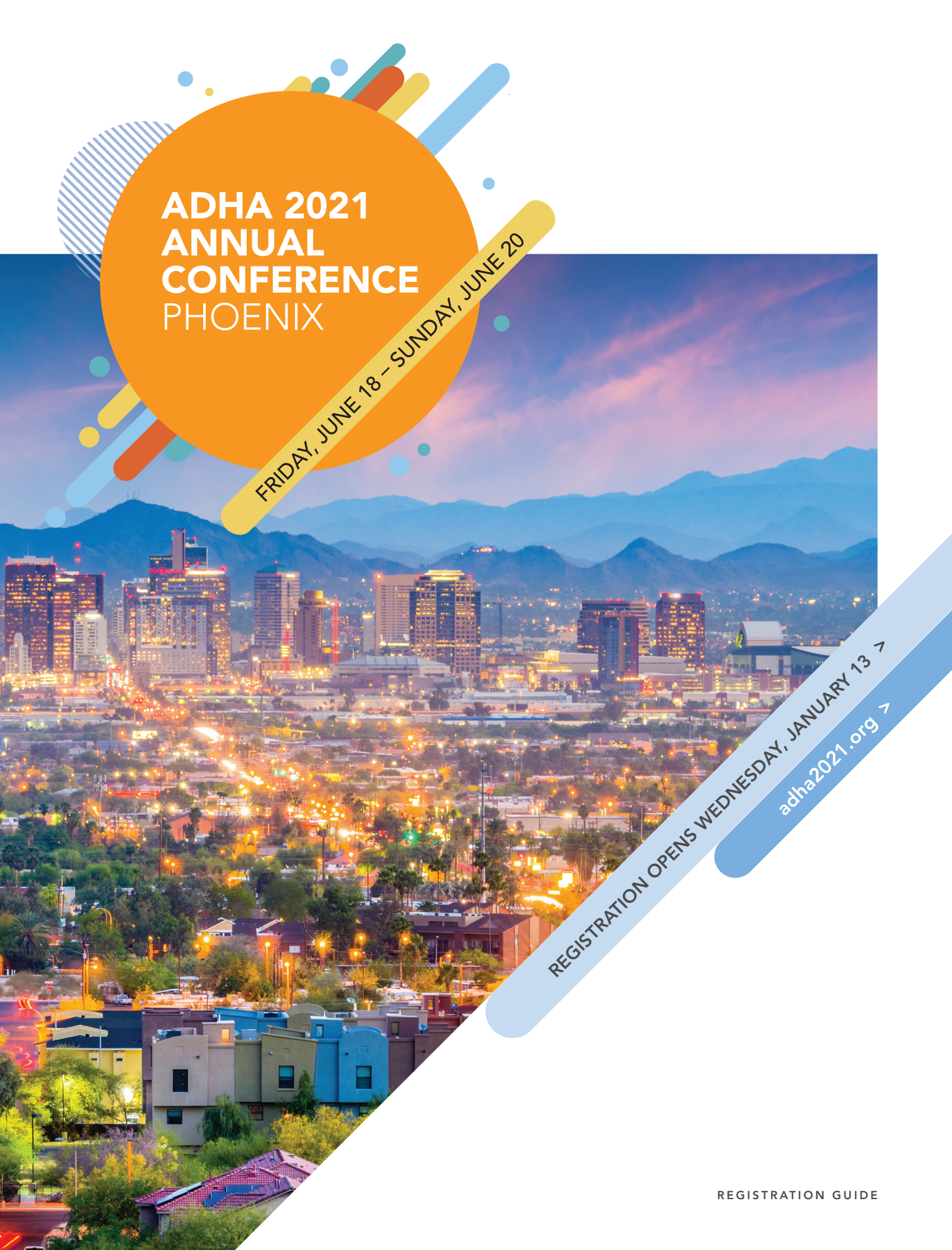

Intermediate:

Expect a more interactive experience with case studies and assessment measures, which require previous knowledge to engage with material and use the information in practical applications.

Audience: 2+ years in practice with an established degree of competence and readiness to build on, apply, or enhance existing knowledge.

Advanced:

Enhance competence in complex procedures, mastering the use of technology, or preparing attendees to lead the training of others.

Audience: 5+ years in practice with significant expertise, knowledge, and experience.

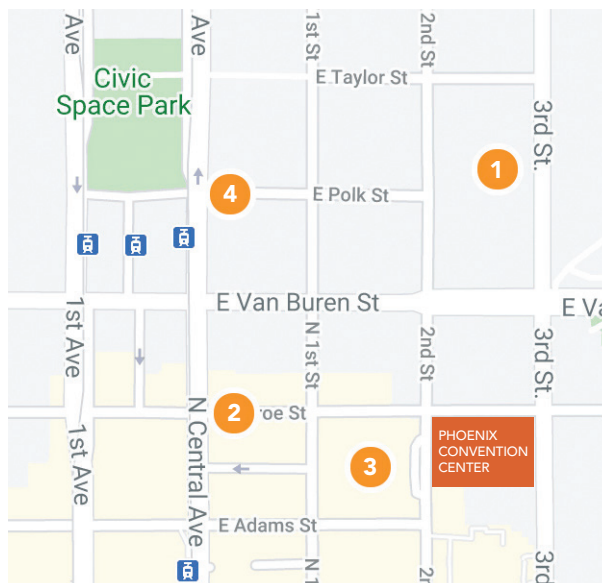

EXPLORING PHOENIX

There are several ways to navigate the city, including public transportation and transportation services such as taxis, rental cars, charter services and ride sharing services.

The Valley Metro Rail runs from central Phoenix, through downtown, to Tempe and Mesa in the east. Stations are close by and run right by some of the area's top attractions, such as the Heard Museum, Phoenix Art Museum, Arizona Science Center, Chase Field, Talking Stick Resort Arena, Arizona State University and more.

A one-way pass on the light rail costs \$2 or an all-day pass is \$4, which can be purchased at the ticket vending machines at each station.

AIRPORT

Sky Harbor, dubbed America's Friendliest Airport, is the main airport for the Greater Phoenix area.

Sky Harbor is served by 18 competitively priced carriers. The airport is located in the middle of Greater Phoenix, less than 10 minutes from downtown, and within 30 minutes of most hotels and resorts.

TAXIS + RIDE SHARING

There is a cab stand right outside of the airport. Fares can range, starting at \$25 each way for one or two people. Ride share services (Uber & Lyft) are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
