The Rafael Núñez International Airport of Cartagena is located inside the urban area of the city in the Crespo neighborhood, just 10 minutes from the historic center and 15 minutes from the hotel zone of the city.

Currently Rafael Nuñez Airport connects Cartagena de Indias with 8 national destinations: Bogotá, Cali, Medellín, Bucaramanga, Pereira, Montería and San Andrés, Cúcuta; and 11 internationals: Lima, Panama City, Miami, Fort Lauderdale, Atlanta, New York, Toronto, Montreal, Amsterdam, Orlando and Mexico and more connections via Bogota.

Use of local transport



Public transport from the airport to the city Centre operates 24 hours a day

Taxi service operates 24 hours a day. City buses from 6:50 a.m. to 11:45 p.m.

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What is the weather like?

The hot season lasts 3.3 months, from May 27 to September 5, and the average daily maximum temperature is more than 31°C (88°F). The warmest month of the year in Cartagena de Indias is June, with an average maximum temperature of 31°C (88°F) and minimum of 25°C (78°F)

How do I secure a group discount?

From 10 to 29 registrations, you receive a 15% discount and a 25% discount for registrations of more than 30 participants, made by the same company.

How do I apply for a visa?

Important information:

1. Participants from other countries: please enter the country with your passport.
2. It is necessary that your passport has a expiration date of more than 6 months.
3. Yellow fever: Colombian authorities will require the yellow fever vaccine if you are going to visit tourist sites such as the Sierra Nevada de Santa Marta National Park, the Tayrona Park and the various Amazon reserves.
4. **Covid:** Present the vaccination card with complete vaccination schedule that proves you have completed the vaccination schedule before 14 days prior to boarding or present a negative PCR test made in advance no more than 72 hours before boarding, or negative antigen test carried out no more than 48 hours before boarding.
5. Fill out the immigration form: the foreigner must make the migratory pre-registration Check-Mig up to 72 hours before the trip and until one hour before the trip begins.

6. **Visa:** among the countries that need a visa to enter Colombia are Belarus, Cape Verde, Congo, Ivory Coast, Chad, Egypt, Ethiopia, Gabon, Gambia, Ghana, Haiti, India, Kenya, Madagascar, Maldives, Mali, Morocco, Nepal, Nicaragua, Niger, Central African Republic, Rwanda, Senegal, Thailand, Tanzania, Ukraine, Vietnam, Zambia and Zimbabwe. 7. Before your trip, please check the Migration Colombia page, to verify the entry requirements to the country and that these have not been modified.
