COURSE DESCRIPTION

The *Advances in Medical and Surgical Management of Thyroid Cancer* course will provide an evidence-based update on the contemporary management of thyroid cancer from diagnosis to treatment. A diverse faculty of endocrinologists and surgeons will cover epidemiology, microcancer, nodule evaluation, selective I-131 use, risk stratification, initial and repeat surgical interventions as well as management of advanced disease and other timely topics. Individual cases will be presented in an interactive format with the panel experts. The utility of ultrasound will be highlighted in the lectures as well as in patient demonstrations.

TARGET AUDIENCE

The target audience for this activity is endocrine surgeons, ENT and head and neck surgeons, radiologists, thyroidologists and endocrinologists, nuclear medicine physicians, nurse practitioners, physician assistants, and sonographers.

NEEDS ASSESSMENT

Care of patients with thyroid nodules varies widely, and differentiating benign nodules from malignancy requiring management remains a clinical challenge. Patients with thyroid nodules may be over- or under-treated for their disease. Clinicians need education on the latest updates to clinical practice guidelines to understand treatment algorithms for patients with thyroid cancer. Clinicians need additional information about recently published clinical results, including advances in diagnosis, imaging, staging, and surveillance as well as surgical and systemic management of thyroid cancer. The application of the current clinical practice guidelines, including recent updates is necessary to improve overall patient care.
