The city was once called Parisii by the Gauls, however the Romans arrived in 52 B.C. later which was changed to Lutetia.

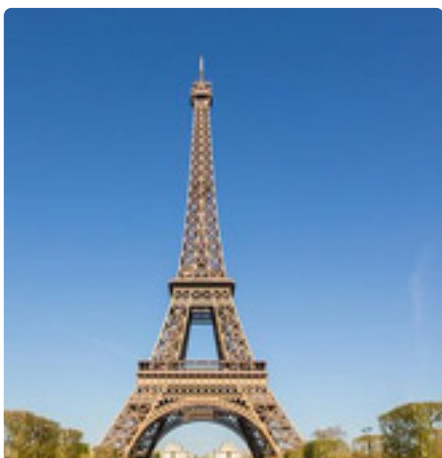

The Famous boulevards and city centre buildings were transformed by Haussmann and Charles Louis Napoléon Bonaparte. The wide streets, places and squares were built and the buildings completely renovated. The atmosphere was totally enchanted Champs-Élysées, whilst preserving historical buildings such as Notre Dame. 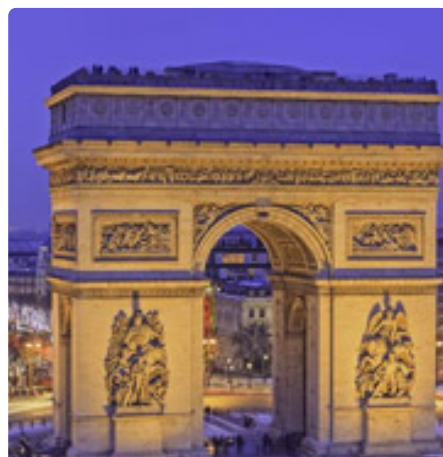
