OVERVIEW

This course is for Perio Residents and Periodontists preparing to take the Oral Exam (Part II) for certification by the American Board of Periodontology; practicing periodontists looking for a comprehensive review and an update in periodontics; and general dentists and dental specialists who are interested in periodontics. Two options for this course are offered, one option (course #01-20-2.5-Video) is for a 2½ day comprehensive review and update. The second option (course #01-20-Video) also includes 1½ days of mock oral board exams after the conclusion of the 2½ day comprehensive review and update.
