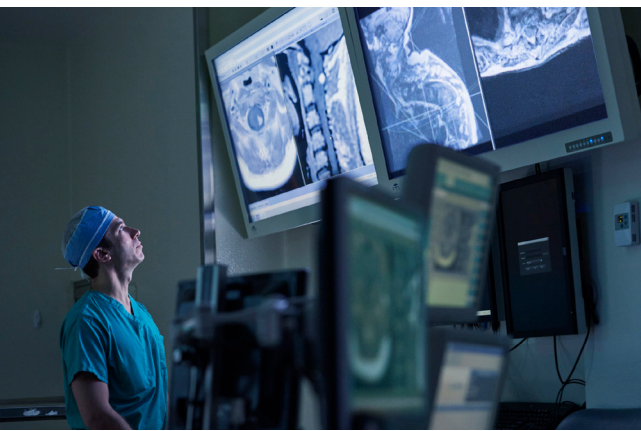

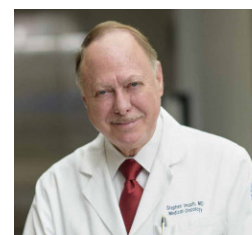
The **target audience** includes physicians, nurses and other healthcare providers from diverse specialties that provide care for cancer patients.
