Dr Daniel Hammer is a Maxillofacial Oncologic and Reconstructive Surgeon at Naval Medical Center San Diego. Following residency training in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery at the Walter Reed National Military Medical Center he completed his fellowships at John Peter Smith Hospital in Fort Worth, Texas. He is an Associate Professor of Surgery at the Uniformed Services University and Voluntary Assistant Clinical Professor of Surgery at UCSD. Dr Hammer received the 2022 Navy Hero of Military Medicine Award



Dr Bach Le completed his specialty training in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery at Oregon Health Sciences University. He is currently Clinical Associate Professor of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery at the Herman Ostrow School of Dentistry of USC where he has been an active faculty member since 2000. Dr Le has lectured internationally on bone regeneration and dental implant-related surgery. His primary focus has been in hard and soft tissue regeneration for improving esthetic outcomes.



Dr Baldwin Marchack earned his DDS from the Herman Ostrow School of Dentistry of USC and MBA from UCLA. He lectures nationally and internationally and is a past president of the American Prosthodontic Society, the Pacific Coast Society for Prosthodontics and the American Academy of Esthetic Dentistry. Dr Marchack is an Honorary Member of the American College of Prosthodontists and Chair Emeritus of the Editorial Council for the Journal of Prosthetic Dentistry. He maintains a private practice in Pasadena.



Dr Russell Nishimura received his BS, DDS and training in Hospital Dentistry, Prosthodontics and Maxillofacial Prosthetics at the UCLA School of Dentistry. He held many positions where he taught removable prosthodontics and chaired the RPD and Immediate Dentures and Osseointegrated Implants courses. Dr Nishimura retired as Professor Emeritus from the Division of Restorative Dentistry. His private practice in Prosthodontics and Implant Dentistry is in Westlake Village.



Dr Simon Oh received his BS at the University of Maryland-College Park in physiology and neurobiology, DDS from the University of Maryland Baltimore; and spent a few years training in oral and maxillofacial surgery at Hahnemann University Hospital and St Christopher's Hospital for Children in Philadelphia. Dr Oh founded a charitable organization in Central America where he performs Zygomatic, Pterygoid, and Transnasal implants. Dr Oh focuses on training doctors in implant surgery



Dr Wayne Ozaki received his DDS at the University of Southern California and his Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery residency MD at the University of Pittsburgh. He was Associate Professor of Surgery at Oregon Health & Sciences University and Chief of Pediatric Plastic and Craniofacial Surgery at OHSU Doernbecher Children's Hospital. Dr Ozaki is Chief of Pediatric Plastic and Craniofacial Surgery, also Chief of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery at UCLA School of Dentistry.

HANDS-ON WORKSHOP FOR DOCTORS
REMOVING THE BROKEN ABUTMENT SCREW FROM AN IMPLANT

Presenter: Baldwin Marchack DDS MBA

In this workshop, participants will learn how to:

1. Evaluate when to use a more conservative vs more aggressive technique
2. Use a hand instrument or a hand-held rotary instrument to tease the remnant out
3. Use a bur to make a horizontal slot to accommodate a flathead or flat blade screwdriver
4. Use a reverse drill and a reverse tap retrieval instrument
5. Use a high-speed round bur to create a counter-clockwise rotation to remove the remnant
