TARGET AUDIENCE AND PURPOSE

The North Carolina Neurological Society is pleased to announce its 2021 Virtual Annual Meeting, scheduled for February 27-28. The target audience for this meeting includes academic and private practice neurologists, residents and fellows in training, and advanced practice providers. This educational activity will update attendees on the latest medical knowledge available from medical literature, clinical experience and research, to keep practitioners on the forefront of new discoveries and their application to the practice of neurology for the benefit of their patients.

OBJECTIVES

- Recognizing neurological complications of COVID-19.
- Ordering appropriate genetic testing for evaluation of inherited neurological disorders.
- Diagnosing and managing peripheral polyneuropathy.
- Utilizing evidence-based approaches to anti-seizure treatment.
- Correlating clinical presentations with neuroanatomic abnormalities.

Sunday features **Eric Anderson, MD, PhD**, a board certified Neurologist, who will be providing a virtual healthcare and coding update and **Ralph Józefowicz, MD**, of the University of Rochester presenting part II of neuroanatomy.

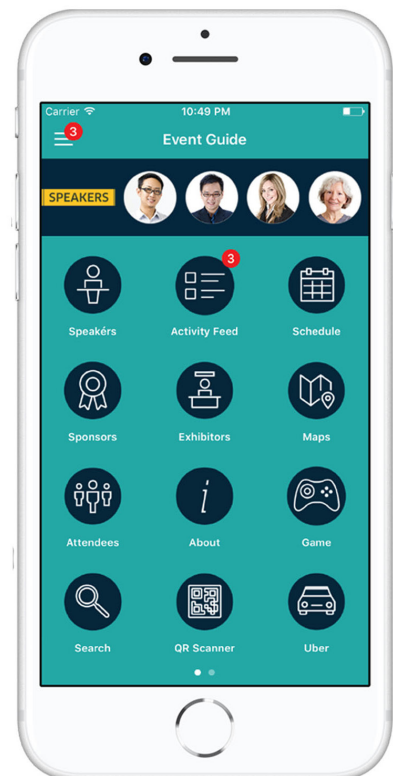
