Each ICL will be presented by International Masters in the field along with POSI faculty. There will be a total of 8 ICLs in 4 halls on the Preconference Day (16th February, 2024).

ICL 1

FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 16, 2024, 14:00 - 16:00 Hrs



BASIC PELVIC OSTEOTOMIES

WHAT IT IS ALL ABOUT

- Every orthopod comes across the names of pelvic osteotomies but there is lack of clarity regarding their differences and their utility.
- This basic pelvic osteotomies ICL aims to dispel some confusion regarding pelvic osteotomies.
- Saw bone hands on workshop and surgical videos will allow the participants to get oriented with the 3-dimensional nature of osteotomies.

ICL 2

FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 16, 2024, 14:00 - 16:00 Hrs



OSTEOTOMIES FOR LEVER ARM DISORDERS IN CEREBRAL PALSY

WHAT IT IS ALL ABOUT

- This course is designed for practitioners who have cerebral palsy patients in large numbers in their practice. Lever arm disorders are difficult situations to encounter in children with cerebral palsy.
- This ICL will discuss about gait patterns, crouch gait, miserable malalignment syndrome, rotational axis disorders.
- Techniques of assessment like Clinical, Gait analysis, rotational profile.
- Discussions, surgical videos and hands on workshop will provide technical details and tips to achieve good outcomes.
- Techniques: Distal femoral extension osteotomy, Patellar tendon advancement, proximal femoral varus osteotomies, derotation osteotomies, foot osteotomies etc.

ICL 3

FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 16, 2024, 14:00 - 16:00 Hrs

**CLUBFOOT****WHAT IT IS ALL ABOUT**

- This course is designed for trainees and practitioners who are interested in treatment of clubfoot children. This course is designed to orient the attendee with all aspects of clubfoot treatment in the neonate and infant including assessment, serial casting, tenotomy, bracing and follow up.
- This session is going to be interactive so that participants can discuss their doubts with experts.
- Hands on workshop for Ponseti casting will give participants good opportunity learn and relearn the perfect technique.

ICL 4

FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 16, 2024, 14:00 - 16:00 Hrs

**DEFORMITY CORRECTION WITH 6-AXIS FACTOR****WHAT IT IS ALL ABOUT**

- This course is designed for practitioners enthusiastic about deformity correction. The 6-axis fixator in various forms is a powerful tool in confronting deformities which are especially complex.
- This ICL will include practical assessment of deformity, planning correction and principles and actual technique of software aided gradual correction of deformity. Participants can have first-hand experience in real 6-axis fixator.
- This workshop will demonstrate how to correct translational, rotational and angular deformities with the help of the fixator and the accompanying software.

ICL 5

FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 16, 2024, 16:15 - 18:15 Hrs

**NON - TRAUMATIC PEDIATRIC UPPER LIMB DISORDERS****WHAT IT IS ALL ABOUT**

- This ICL is for specialists who take keen interest in Pediatric Upper Limb disorders. This ICL aims to take the participants through a journey of upper limb disorders which is thought to be complex and sensitive field but is equally rewarding if performed with dedication and meticulous perfection.
- This ICL will discuss about topics like limb deficiencies, radial club hand, radioulnar synostosis, thumb aplasia, radial head dislocation, brachial plexus palsy, upper limb arthrogyrosis, syndactyly, madelung deformity and many more.
- Useful surgical videos, instrumentation, assessment post-operative protocol and therapy will also be an integral part of the ICL.

ICL 6

FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 16, 2024, 16:15 - 18:15 Hrs



GAIT ANALYSIS FOR THE NOVICE

WHAT IT IS ALL ABOUT

- This course is designed for practitioners of all levels with an interest in normal gait and pathologic gait associated with a variety of pediatric orthopaedic conditions.
- This is designed to demystify a complex subject. Participants, without prior exposure or experience, can learn about use of quantitative gait analysis for assessment and clinical decision-making.
- Introduce the various elements of Quantitative gait analysis and application of this approach to a variety of clinical conditions.
- Case based examples to illustrate the principles and applications of 2D and 3D Gait Analysis in clinical situations.

ICL 7

FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 16, 2024, 16:15 - 18:15 Hrs



CORONAL PLANE DEFORMITIES IN CHILDREN

WHAT IT IS ALL ABOUT

- This ICL is designed for thorough discussion into the coronal plane deformities, mainly around joints, particularly the knee. This ICL seeks to emphasise the need for a clear knowledge in management of genu valgum and varum and similar conditions like Blounts disease.
- This ICL will discuss about assessment, how to take perfect scanogram for planning, estimation of bone age and growth remaining.
- Various techniques of growth modulation (8 plates, PETS etc.), epiphysiodesis, osteotomies etc. will be discussed. Surgical videos, saw bone workshops are going to make this topic all the more immersive.

ICL 8

FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 16, 2024, 16:15 - 18:15 Hrs



DDH BEFORE WALKING AGE

WHAT IT IS ALL ABOUT

- This course is for practitioners who come across developmental dysplasia of hip.
- This is an interactive session where the participants can discuss about the true incidence of DDH in Indian and global scenario, early diagnosis of DDH and risk factors.
- This will also entail discussion into the screening and diagnostic tools for DDH in neonates like ultrasound, its utilities and limitations.
- This will also discuss the guidelines for screening, diagnosis and management pathways like IHDI and DDH Care pathway for DDH in neonates and infants.
- This will also empower the participants to propagate their knowledge to colleagues like paediatricians and primary care givers of neonates.

MAIN CONFERENCE DAY 1

FEBRUARY 17, 2024

The theme for this conference is: Transforming Knowledge into Practice and Practice into evidence. It emphasizes that practitioners contribute to research through their daily work, generating valuable information. The event aims to promote rational thinking, evidence-based discussions, and the sharing of knowledge and skills to foster progressive wisdom in the field of Pediatric Orthopaedics.



TRAUMA MODULE : 08:00-09:30 Hrs, FEBRUARY 17, 2024

Children are not miniature adults. In pediatric trauma, many of the anatomic factors are not visible in the radiographs and the periosteum is one of them. This trauma module is sure to trigger a transformation in the understanding of skeletal trauma by highlighting the role of periosteum in fracture healing, the skill of looking at this invisible entity and utilising its attributes to achieve desirable outcomes.



HIP MODULE : 09:30-11:00 Hrs, FEBRUARY 17, 2024

Practitioners interested in paediatric hip disorders are sure to get their questions addressed in this session. The hip module will discuss about hip problem in children including, but not limited to DDH, Legg Calve Perthes Disease, Slipped Capital Femoral Epiphysis and will try to provide evidence based practice guidelines.



TUMOUR MODULE : 15:30-16:30 Hrs, FEBRUARY 17, 2024

How to evaluate a swelling or a lytic lesion? How to differentiate a benign tumour from a malignant one? What to do in a bone cyst? Which exostoses to excise? How well do megaprotheses do? How early can we do a total joint replacement in a person? These and many more answers are waiting for the participants in the tumour module.



NEUROMUSCULAR MODULE : 16:30-17:30 Hrs, FEBRUARY 17, 2024

This module will provide update on current evidence on Cerebral Palsy, Myopathies, Muscular Dystrophies, Developmental Delays, Neural Tube Defects and other neuromuscular disorders. This session will also provide guidelines for assessment and management of each of these entities.



NEUROMUSCULAR FOOT MODULE : 17:30-18:30 Hrs, FEBRUARY 17, 2024

This session intends to settle the prevailing dilemma in treating feet of children suffering from neuromuscular disorders. How to differentiate flexible feet from rigid and painful ones, how to evaluate a pes cavus foot, how to manage an insensate foot in neural tube defects, how to address deformities due to underlying condition, what are the newest guidelines on management of foot issues : these are some of the many questions the session will try to answer.

INFECTION MODULE : 08:00-09:00 Hrs, FEBRUARY 18, 2024

What is the evidence based practice in children's osteoarticular infections? What are the usual and unusual presentations? What is unique about neonatal infections? What investigations are sensitive? How long to continue injectable antibiotics? How to suspect, confirm and treat Tubercular infections? These are the questions this infection module is designed to seek answers to.



SPORTS INJURY MODULE : 09:15-10:00 Hrs, FEBRUARY 18, 2024

Every other kid in this country is a sports enthusiast. As involvement in sports activities is increasing, so are injuries and concerns regarding their effect in performance. Orthopaedic surgeons must have a crisp idea about sports injuries and similar conditions like discoid meniscus, patellar instability, hyperlaxity syndromes, popliteal cysts, Osteochondritis, rigid and symptomatic flatfeet etc. This module aims to settle common doubts regarding these issues.



EXPERT'S PREFERRED TECHNIQUE : 10:15 - 12:00 Hrs, FEBRUARY 18, 2024

This is a roller coaster of rapid sequence of video lectures. This crash course is studded with vital video techniques of office practice like casting etc and surgical procedures which are common in orthopaedic practice. This session is set to pace the tempo of the conference and keep everyone on their toes while providing valuable tips.



PEARLS IN PRACTICE FOR MID - CAREER PEDIPOD : 12:15 - 13:00 Hrs, FEBRUARY 18, 2024

This is an immensely enriching session for the established Pediatric Orthopaedic Surgeons which discusses the common issues in a pedipod's professional life. Setting an establishment, expanding practice, making a change in the society, teaching, opening fellowship programs, giving it back to the society, formulating guidelines, contributing to research; these are few of the goals a pedipod looks forward to. For a young pedipod, this session will provide a peek into the future and prepare him for what is going to come.

Scientific Research can be presented at POSICON 2024, Guwahati, in the following two categories :

1. Podium presentations
 - a. Free paper - 5 minutes + 2 minutes discussion
 - b. Best paper - 7 minutes + 2 minutes discussion
2. Poster

Last Date for Submission of Abstracts: September 30, 2023.

Only ONLINE submission through website, www.posi.in will be accepted.

Only registered delegates can submit an abstract.

A delegate can submit more than one abstract, but only one can be presented per delegate. If more than one abstract gets accepted, the presenting author may nominate a co-author to present the paper. The co-author has to be registered for the conference. The co-author has to have been included at the time of abstract submission. No co-authors can be added later.

Supporting material in the form of tables, graphs and photos may be submitted (Upto a maximum of 5 only with maximum file size of 5 MB for all attachments).

Do not mention name of Author(s) or Institution in the Title, Body of the abstract or in the images, tables and graphs. Mentioning the same will automatically disqualify the submission.

The abstracts must be submitted along with the details of the author intending to present the paper as listed below :

1. The name of the person presenting the paper.
2. The names of co-authors (if any).
3. The POSI membership number of the presenting author.
4. The name and address of the institution where the investigation was conducted.

Guidelines for POSI Best Paper session :

From among the highest ranked papers, the first 10 papers fulfilling all of the following criteria will be selected for this session.

1. The presenting author should be a POSI Member or should have applied for POSI membership at the time of abstract submission.
2. The study should be largely his / her work.
3. The work should have been done in India.
