Featured Speaker: Deepak Krishnan, DDS, FACS



Dr. Deepak Krishnan is the chief of Oral Maxillofacial surgery at both the University of Cincinnati and Cincinnati Children's Hospital and Medical Center. He is an associate professor of Surgery at the College of Medicine at the University of Cincinnati where he teaches and practices.

Dr. Krishnan also serves as the residency program director at the University of Cincinnati's advanced training program in OMS and is a Fellow of the American College of Surgeons. He obtained his dental degree from Bangalore University, India and trained in OMS at Emory University's College of Medicine in Atlanta, Georgia. Upon completion of his residency, he pursued further fellowship training in OMS, focusing on orthognathic surgery at Dalhousie University in Halifax, Canada.

Dr. Krishnan's clinical interests are in orthognathic and reconstructive surgery, maxillofacial trauma, pediatric maxillofacial surgery, ambulatory anesthesia and clinical research and simulation. He currently serves on the Committee of Education and Training for AAOMS and is the chair of the Special Committee on Emerging Leaders in OMS. He is a consultant to the AAOMS Committee on Anesthesia and a past-president of the Ohio State Society of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons. He is the president of the Ohio Dental Society of Anesthesiology and serves as an examiner for ABOMS.
