Biological and Technical Concepts that Influence the Endodontic Treatment Outcome

Dr. Fabricio Teixeira

In the last few years, we've noticed the incorporation of new ideas challenging the classic approaches to endodontic treatment. The use of real-time 3D analysis, magnifications, conforming files, and non-invasive Micro CT evaluations of the root canal anatomy have introduced innovative viewpoints on preservation of tooth structure, root canal disinfection, and tooth survivability. However, some of these theories have not yet supported by the existing evidence. This presentation intends to address the important aspects of endodontic practice based on the most current evidence in the literature. The reasons to incorporate limited volume CBCT, magnification, thermal-treated instruments, and Bioceramic materials will be discussed as well as the biological standpoints regarding the management of the mature and immature permanent teeth with apical periodontitis.

Objectives:

1. Explain the decision-making process based on contemporary technology and materials.
2. Recite the treatment alternatives and proper approaches on immature permanent teeth with apical periodontitis.
3. Identify and explain the paramount evidence-based treatment outcomes and prognosis.

Dentists who attend all three courses will earn a total of 11.5 CEUs.

Each continuing education activity is presented in a lecture format, with audio-visual accompaniment and an opportunity for questions.

Speaker Bio



Dr. Fabricio Teixeira is Professor and Chair of the Department of Endodontics at the University of Iowa. Before moving to Iowa, he served as Director of the Advanced Education Program in Endodontics at the University of Texas at San Antonio, where he obtained his certificate in endodontics. He also served as Associate Professor in the Department of Endodontics at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill and still maintains his appointment as Adjunct Professor.

Dr. Teixeira is Diplomate of the American Board of Endodontics. He holds a position as endodontic consultant of the ADA for the Commission on Dental Accreditation. He is member of the OKU National Dental Honor Society and Fellow of the International College of Dentists. He has served in many capacities at the American Association of Endodontists, including as Chair of the 2018 World

Congress of Dental Traumatology Organizing Committee and Director of the American Board of Endodontics.

He is Associate Editor of Endodontic Topics, Evidence-Based Endodontics and Visual Endodontics. He holds a position on the Scientific Advisory Board of the Journal of Endodontics and serves as peer reviewer on several other international journals. He has received numerous awards, including the 2015 JOE Award for the best article of the year. He was the first recipient of the Endowment Carlos E. del Rio Distinguished Professorship in Endodontics at the University of Texas and the Richard E. Walton Professorship in Endodontics at University of Iowa. He is actively involved in clinical research and has lectured nationally and internationally on several topics in endodontics. He has published over 100 manuscripts in peer-reviewed journals, many abstracts and textbook chapters. He also maintains a private practice limited to endodontics in Iowa City.
