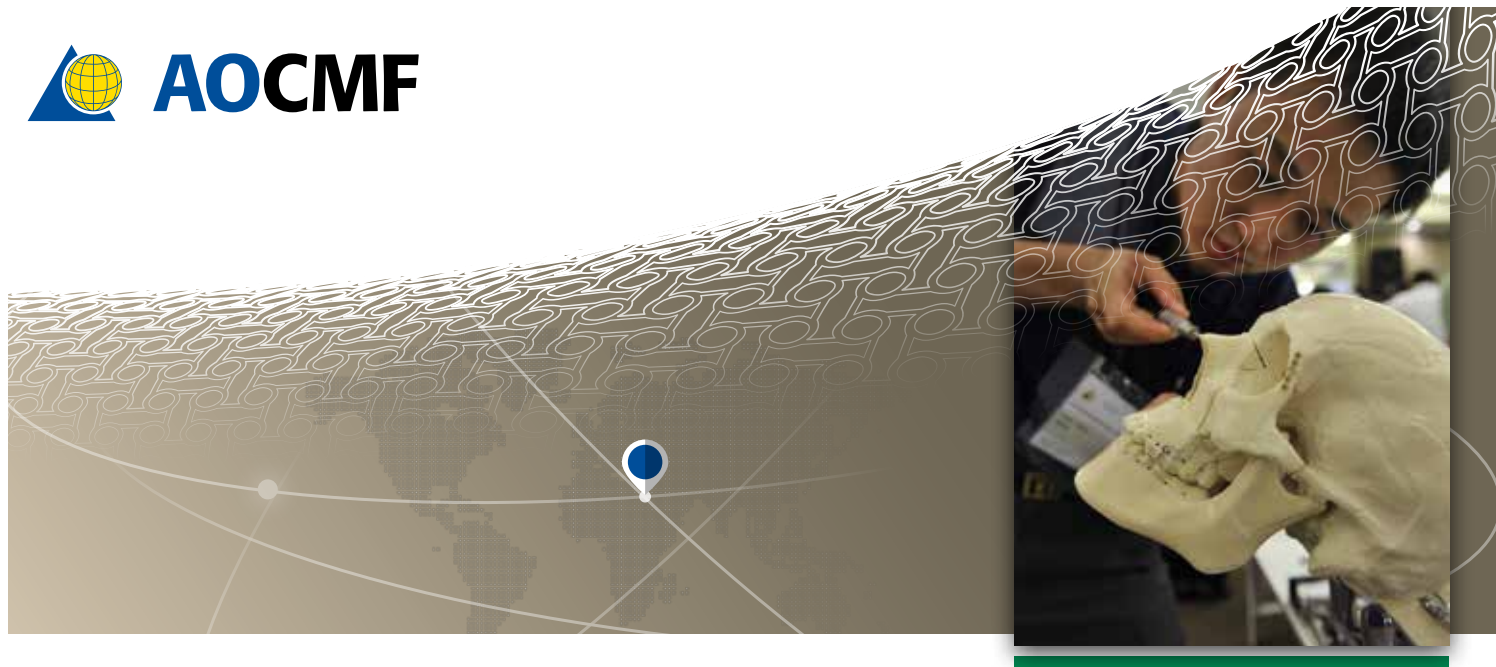




AOCMF Course—Management of Facial Trauma
