10:00 am - 11:00 am ***Macular Disease When It's Not AMD*** *1 hr CE credit
Disorders of the macula that are not age-related macular degeneration cause vision loss. Etiologies include infectious, age-related, genetic, systemic and potentially cancerous. This course will outline some masqueraders of AMD and their differentials as well as management.

11:00 am - 12:00 pm ***Retina Mysteries Revealed*** *1 hr CE credit
Using a series of unusual and classic presentations, this course will offer the attendee a challenge for diagnosis and management. In addition, the diagnostic and management strategies will be discussed.

12:30 pm - 1:30 pm ***Imaging Techniques in Glaucoma*** *1 hr CE credit
Imaging in glaucoma has evolved rapidly in the past decade. Understanding the potential and pitfalls of digital imaging is becoming critical to the earliest diagnosis of glaucoma. In addition, new paradigms for the assessment of progression have emerged and continue to evolve. This course will present a contemporary template for diagnosis and management of glaucoma using digital imaging.

1:30 pm - 2:30 pm ***IOP in Perspective*** *1 hr CE credit
While intraocular pressure is the only FDA-approved means to manage glaucoma, its measurement is fraught with inaccuracies and a myriad of influences. This course will explore those vagaries to give the attendee a perspective on the moving target that IOP is.



Leo P. Semes, OD, FAAO, FACMO, of Bloomington, AL

Dr. Semes, OD, earned his OD from PCO and completed residency at The Eye Institute of PCO. He is former Professor of Optometry at UAB.

Dr. Semes has authored or over 250 articles, book chapters and posters. He is a fellow of the AAO, as well as an active member of the AOA. Dr. Semes is a founding member of the Optometric Glaucoma Society and a founding fellow of the Optometric Retina Society. In 2015, he was recognized as one of the 50 "most influential individuals in eye care" by Optometric Management magazine and received the Educator of the Year award (2015) from the Alabama Optometric Association. Recently he was recognized with the Dean's Distinguished Service award (2016).
