

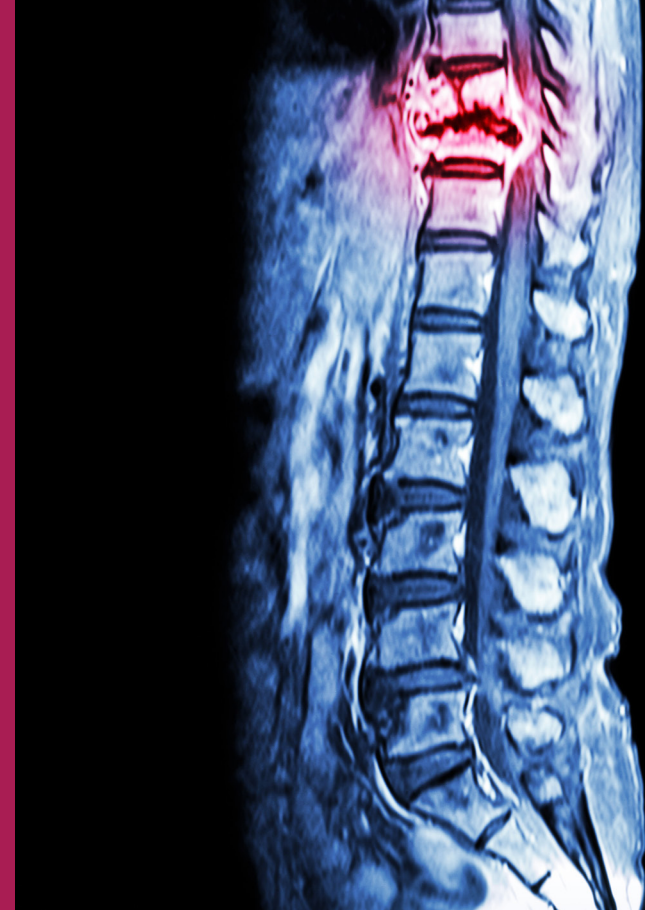

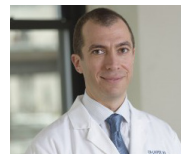
EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES
