The Linton-Poodry SACNAS Leadership Institute (LPSLI) provides premier training for motivated underrepresented minority (URM) scientists who wish to master the skills necessary to lead institutional transformation. Developed in collaboration with the American Association for the Advancement of Science (AAAS), the LPSLI is an intensive five-day course featuring small group exercises, keynote speakers, leadership development planning, networking opportunities, and extensive community building among selected participants.

Eligibility:

- Must be a SACNAS member at the time of application
- Doctorate degree required
- STEM field preferred
- Postdocs and professionals in academia, industry, government, and non-profits are invited to apply
- Applications are reviewed by a committee of SACNAS members and leaders

The LPSLI is a fully funded program that provides travel, hotel and some meals for its participants.
