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Educational Objectives

At the completion of the meeting, attendees should be able to:

- Describe a wide range of imaging techniques and pathologies encountered in the pediatric head and neck

- Know practical approaches for imaging pediatric patients with cervical adenopathy, branchial plexus injury, central diabetes insipidus and suspected leukodystrophy

- Describe pertinent features and use appropriate nomenclature for extraaxial findings in abusive head trauma

- Categorize vascular malformations of the head and neck and become familiar with major associated syndromes and standard treatment options
- Implement strategies to reduce the use of anesthesia using preparation and motion mitigation techniques
- Evaluate patients with a Chiari 1 deformity and understand associated prognostic findings
- Understand autoimmune and demyelinating processes in the children including emerging diseases and biomarkers

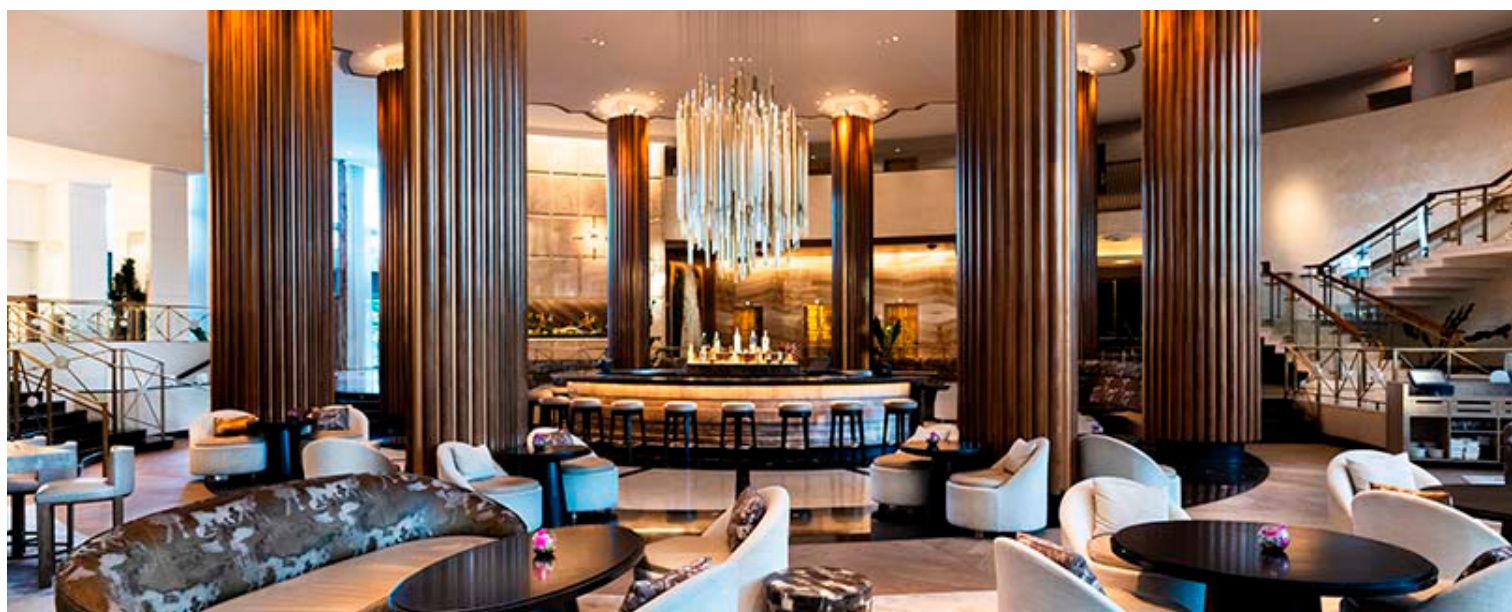
