



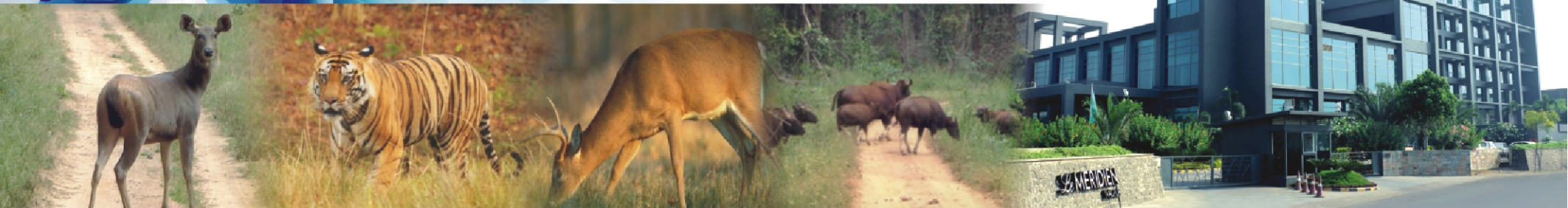

Nagpur is the second capital and the third most populous city of the Indian state of Maharashtra. It is a major commercial and political center of the Vidarbha region of Maharashtra. Nagpur has been identified as the best city in India by topping the liveability, greenery, public transport, and health care indices. Nagpur has the best literacy, 93.13% among cities with more than 20 lakhs population in India. It is famous for the Oranges and is known as the “Orange City” for being a major trade center of oranges cultivated in the region.

The average maximum daytime temperature in Nagpur in January is a warm 29°C (84°F). The average night-time temperature is usually a cool 13°C (55°F).

Nagpur is also called the “Tiger Capital of India” as it connects many tiger reserves in India to the world. It is among the important cities for the information technology sector in Maharashtra. Nagpur lies at the dead center of the country with the Zero Mile marker indicating the geographical center of India. The city was rated as the best “Indian city to live in”.

HOW TO GET HERE ?

Air : The nearest airport is Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar International Air Port which is 7 kms. from conference venue. Daily flights of Jet Airways, Indigo, Air India connect Nagpur with Mumbai, Delhi, Calcutta, Bangalore, Hyderabad & Pune.

Railway : The nearest railway station is in the heart of city which is well connected with all major cities.

Road : National Highway No. 6 & 7 cross through Nagpur and the city is well connected by road to almost all parts of India.

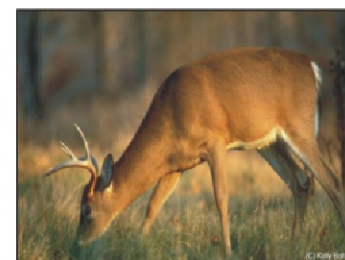

Pachmarhi : It is 275 kms. from city. It is a peaceful hill station. It is most verdant jewel located in Madhya Pradesh, where nature has found exquisite expression in mountains.

Nagzira & Navegaon Tiger Reserve : Nagzira wildlife sanctuary is located between Bhandara district and Gondia district of Maharashtra. Nagzira wildlife sanctuary is locked in terms of nature and adorned with a picturesque landscape, luxuriant vegetation and serves as a living outdoor museum to explore and appreciate nature. This sanctuary has a number of fish, 34 species of mammals, 166 species of birds, 36 species of reptiles and four species of amphibians.



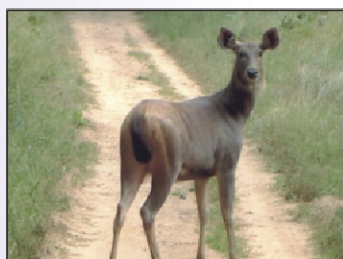
The invertebrate fauna includes, a number of insects and ant species. Wild animals found here are the tiger, bison, sambar, nilgai, chital, wild boar, sloth bear, barking deers, mouse deer and wild dog. Nearly 30,000 tourist visits this sanctuary annually.



Tadoba - Andhari Tiger Reserve : Tadoba Andhari Reserve is a Tiger reserve in Chandrapur district of Maharashtra state in central India. It is notable as Maharashtra's oldest and largest National Park. It is one of India's 43 "Project Tiger" - Tiger reserves.

The name 'Tadoba' is the name of the God "Tadoba" or "Taru", praised by the tribal people who live in the dense forests of the Tadoba and Andhari region, while the Andhari River that meanders through the forest gives the 'Andhari' name.

Kanha : It is located at 275 kms. from city. It is situated in the pristine forest of Central Indian State of Madhya Pradesh. It is one of the best place in India to observe the tiger's activity.



Pench National Park : Pench national park is situated in Seoni and Chhindwara districts of Madhya Pradesh in India. It derives its name from the Pench River that flows through national park from north to south dividing the park into almost equal western and eastern halves-the well forested areas of Seoni and Chhindwara districts respectively. It was declared a sanctuary in 1977 but raised to status of National Park in 1983. Later it was established as Tiger Reserve area in 1992. In year 2011 this park won the best management award. This park is accessible from Pauni on National Highway 7. This point is close to Nagpur, Maharashtra and is most convenient to enter from Nagpur. Park have two famous gates as

tourist entry, Turiya and Karmazari.
